## Deepen The Ties That Bind

This coming Sunday we will be exploring the parable of the sower and the seed. This parable is a reminder for us to be faithful to the work of the Kingdom; when we can see results and when we cannot, our task is to be faithful. Our Building Team's update in Church Conference was exciting. There is much happening inside the building including dry wall and painting in classroom spaces. Finishing work is beginning in the Sanctuary: the pews have been ordered and progress continues in all areas of the new addition. I know that this has been a great deal of change and transition for us; however, I am so proud of the way that our congregation has handled this challenge. We literally are entering into the final quarter of this process. Continue to pray for those who work on the project. Pray for our Building Team and their leadership and decisions. Pray for our congregation to remain faithful until the project is completed. Most importantly, let us pray for how this new space will be used to worship God, bring people to Christ and help us grow in Christian maturity.

This coming Sunday evening we continue our "Being the Presence of Christ" series. This week our guest will be Mike Smith, President and COO of Kane Realty here in Raleigh. Mike has been one of the leaders who have cast the vision for what we now know as North Hills and Midtown. Mike will be with us to share what is happening at North Hills and more about that vision of community. We will explore together what role the church can play in our community. 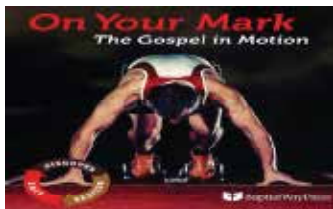

# NC DISASTER RELIEF UPDATE Hurricanes: Matthew/Harvey/Irma

**EASTERN NC** - Trinity is still working in the Lumberton area to help do finishing work on homes damaged by Hurricane Matthew ('16) and are almost ready for the families to move back in. We had a very successful trip in September. Next scheduled mission: **October 18-21. Sign up on Poster on ROC Bulletin Board.**

**TEXAS** - Currently we are preparing approximately 9,500 meals/day on Manna One Feeding Unit, serving in the Nederland and Port Arthur areas. In addition, we have over 130 homes to clean out from the flooding. More volunteers are needed. **Sign up at [www.baptistsonmission.org/hurricaneharvey](http://www.baptistsonmission.org/hurricaneharvey).**

**FLORIDA** - Feeding Unit 2 (30,000/meals per day) is set up in South Miami and is providing hurricane victims with meals from S. Miami down through the Keys. They also have a drinking water tanker and additional support equipment and teams. Recovery Unit 2 and other volunteers are preparing the staging area site and equipment for helping those affected by Hurricane Irma. Recovery Volunteers will be called up shortly

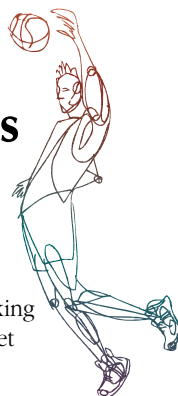
