Last year we filled 6 tractor trailer trucks with shoeboxes (38,146) going to children in war-torn and poverty stricken countries– each with a Gospel pamphlet written in their language. We hope to do even more this year...especially with the islands of the Caribbean in shambles after the hurricanes.

Volunteer shifts will be 2 hours each (except for 2 shifts of 3 hours). We need 2 HEAVY LIFTERS on each shift to load cartons 5 high onto the truck. Also, we need 8 volunteers on each shift to do the other jobs.



Mission Friends where we made missions tangible for our preschoolers! When Christy Frisbee (Mission Friends Director) and I were planning this past summer for our year in Mission Friends this was one of our goals for the year! During this first missions moment we wanted to connect back to our mission project of collecting food for Urban Ministries. We began by having each child draw a picture of their family. Then they each had 2 dollars (of monopoly money) to buy two pieces of healthy food that had been placed on the table in front of them. We then asked them if that would be enough to feed their entire family. They began to realize that it was not! We then talked about how God loves us all and wants us to help others who are in need. We went over basic Bible thoughts such as, "God loves us." (Psalm 107:1) "Help One Another" (Gal. 5:13) "Love one another" (1 John 4:7).

Our goal during this time was to help them know that God loves all of us and to develop a sense of kindness and concern about others and to show God's love to people in need. We wanted them to know that they too can be a person, even when they are young, that helps others! I encourage you as parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, Sunday School teachers, ETC volunteer, etc to work to continue to nurture those seeds of kindness and compassion towards others in need-- it's never too early to begin with our children!
