# Deepen The Ties That Bind

This past Sunday we approved our 2018 budget with a 527 to 4 vote. I want to thank our Finance Committee, Trustees and all our committees who were a part of this process. Preparing a budget of 3 million dollars is a difficult task. At Trinity our budget is truly a "Faith Budget." Our budget reflects our faith in what God is doing in us and through us at Trinity. We believe that God is at work in our world and our church and we are called to join in God's work. We have faith that what we do in ministry has an eternal significance. This is a faith budget because we have faith in each other. We believe that we will be faithful in our giving to our church. As I stated Sunday, there is no one who will magically deposit 3 million dollars in our bank account come January 1, 2018. You and I will support the budget. People who work hard each week to support themselves and their families, but who also believe that everything is a gift from God and give cheerfully and joyfully to the work of the church will support our budget. This is a faith budget because one of the ways we demonstrate faith is obedience. The Bible instructs us to tithe our income and also to be cheerful givers. When we follow the Bible's instructions we are acting out of faith.

I hope that you will join my family in supporting our congregation's work with your tithes and offerings. The Bible describes giving as planned, systematic and joyful. The tithe, or the giving of the first 10% of your income, is achieved through personal budgeting and a systematic way of giving. My family has discovered that the best way for us to give in this manner is through the auto-draft system offered at our church. Each year I meet with our Financial Administrator and set up the amount that will be drafted directly from my bank account. In this way, the funds are given to the church in a systematic and timely manner. It also helps me to be a regular and obedient giver. My giving is not connected to my schedule, travel, or how I might feel about the church's work in a given week. Instead, my giving is based on intentional obedience to the commands of scripture. This guards me from using what belongs to God for my own use, as we are all tempted to do. I have found that the auto-draft system works best for our family and helps us be obedient in giving.

There are other ways you can give to the church as well. You can give through our offerings in worship. This is a wonderful way to participate in our time of worship. You can set up bill-pay with your bank and give electronically. You can also give stocks and assets. If you would like more information on how to set up auto-draft or how to give in other ways beyond the normal offering times, then please contact our Financial Administrator, Jan Brown, at the church office. She will be happy to help you in any way.

I want to thank you for always being faithful in giving. I pray that if you have not discovered the joy of giving, you will make it a priority for your family this coming year. As always, it is a joy to be your pastor.
