Some examples of gifts are: holiday/fuzzy socks, soccer/ basketball, candy, nail polish, playing cards/ games, or anything (inexpensive) that you think a 11-13 year old boy or girl might like. Then, on November 29th, you will be given extra time to bring and package these items during D-Teams. Whatever your D-Team chooses to give will help to make this a joyful Christmas for a student in need!


