## A Message from our Building Committee

Over the past few weeks there have been a number of Trinity Members asking the contractor if they could tour the new Sanctuary and classrooms. The contractor is not comfortable refusing these requests, but it puts our contractor in a precarious position.

Clancy & Theys' insurance company has very strict regulations about how projects are run and how safety rules are enforced. After all, it is the insurance company that is responsible if someone, who is not even authorized by them, should be injured on the site. Being asked to be allowed to tour the building puts Clancy & Theys in the uncomfortable position of either ignoring their own insurance company's requirements or refusing access to members of the church whose requests they also want to honor.

We've only a couple more months until the project is completed. During that time the contractor will have many workers onsite for 10-12 hours per day, six days per week. Please help us by honoring our contractor's responsibilities.


