## Jesus as Savior

As a child matures through the elementary years, he moves from the stage of knowing Jesus as Friend to an increasing understanding of Jesus as Savior. For a child, becoming a Christian happens in "bits and pieces" over the years and in one "big event." Parents work with the Holy Spirit in the "bits and pieces" process, laying the foundations that introduce the child to Jesus as friend. Then the Holy Spirit in the "big event" calls the child to accept Christ as Savior. Part of the Holy Spirit's role is to reveal to the child his personal sin. A child must realize that he/she is lost before he/she can be saved. This process requires time and patience.

When a child begins to ask questions, it may only signal the early stages of acquiring more information. Both the child and Holy Spirit should be in the driver's seat, setting the pace and course for discussion. The "big event" occurs at different ages for individual children since each child is unique in his/her relationship with God.

There is no separate gospel for children. The child must understand and be convicted of his broken relationship with God. Parents must be sensitive to the Holy Spirit's work. Where there is no conviction, there can be no real change and spiritual conversion. Decisions that last a lifetime are decisions based on conviction and conversion.


