## Deepen The Ties That Bind

This past Sunday was a wonderful time of worship at Trinity. I always count it a joy as we come to the Lord's Table together. When we observe the Lord's Supper at Trinity we have several traditions. We have a food drive and benevolence offering for North Raleigh Ministries on those special days. It is a reminder that when we come to the table of the Lord we are reminded of Jesus' commands to care for those who are in need in our community. When we observe the Lord's Supper we also close our time of worship by singing "Blest Be the Tie That Binds." This wonderful hymn reminds us that we come to the table as individuals and we also come as the Body of Christ. At the Lord's Table we are reminded that we have all been welcomed into the family of God. We are reminded, as we learned this past week, we are the children of God and that is who we are!

When we come to the Lord's Table as a congregation, we also have the tradition of reading our church covenant together. I know that there are many times we might read that covenant and not give thought to what we are reading. Yet, every time I read our covenant I find the words to be so profound and inspiring. In particular, I have always found our church's statement to include all as loved by Christ and to choose cooperation with other confessing Christians to be some of the most beautiful words we express in worship. This part of covenant reads:

*"We covenant to live as Christians in our community and in our world, to be exemplary in our conduct and just in our dealings, to engage in a Christian vocation and a Christian witness in the world, to include all people everywhere within the circle of our missionary concern and love, and to regard all people who worship Christ as Savior and Lord as of the household of faith, the Body of Christ. As we engage to teach and to nurture our Baptist heritage, we shall seek also a unity of spirit and action with all Christians."*

I pray each of us as will daily seek to live up to this covenant confession. I pray we will see all people as loved by God. I pray we will choose to focus not on the things that might divide us but on the one purpose that is grander than all others...the Kingdom of God and the good news of Jesus.

This coming Sunday we will explore John's words, "This is the message that you have heard from the beginning. We should love one another." I hope you will join us.

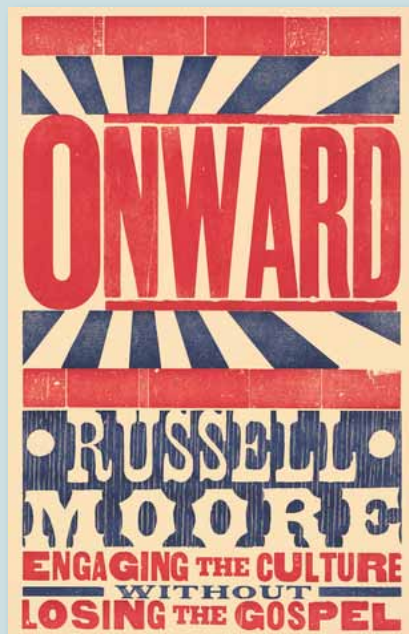
