

## "Becoming a Church Member"

#### To Accept Jesus as Lord means you must:

- Feel sorry that you have not followed God's Way.
- Give up your own way and turn to Jesus.
- Give your life to Jesus.

You must talk to Jesus and tell him about your sins, ask forgiveness, and tell him you want to live for him all your life. We do this through prayer on our own.


