## Deepen The Ties That Bind

In his book "The Forgotten God," Francis Chan quotes A. W. Tozer by stating:

*We may as well face it: the whole level of spirituality among us is low. We have measured ourselves by ourselves until the incentive to seek higher plateaus in the things of the Spirit is all but gone.... We have imitated the world, sought popular favor, manufactured delights to substitute for the joy of the Lord and produced a cheap synthetic power to substitute for the power of the Holy Ghost.*

This coming Sunday is Pentecost Sunday, the day we celebrate the fulfillment of the promise of Jesus to send us the Holy Spirit to empower the church. Yet, this day will go by in many congregations unnoticed or without celebration. We fully embrace the Christmas and the promise of the coming Messiah. We comprehend that without the cross and resurrection our faith is without meaning. Yet, when it comes to thinking about the role of the Holy Spirit and celebrating the Spirit's presence we are confused and dismissive. Yet, the coming of the Holy Spirit is in essence the birth of the church. It is the power of the Holy Spirit that transforms the lives of those who had walked with Jesus. It is the power of the Spirit that drove them from upper rooms into the public street with the good news of Jesus.

In his book, Francis Chan reminds us of seven important characteristics of the Holy Spirit:

1. The Holy Spirit is a person. The Holy Spirit is not a "thing" or a "power" but a person with whom we have a relationship.
2. The Holy Spirit is God. The Holy Spirit is not a lesser being than God but is as fully God as Jesus is fully God.
3. The Holy Spirit is eternal and holy.
4. The Holy Spirit has a mind and prays for us.
5. The Holy Spirit has emotion.
6. The Holy Spirit has desires and a will.
7. The Holy Spirit is omnipotent, omnipresent and omniscient.

This coming Sunday we will be reminded of the power of the Holy Spirit and the Spirit's work in our lives. Join us for this special day of worship.
