One of the most powerful moments for me at church is our monthly Deacons' Meeting. When our deacons meet, we have devotion, discuss matters in the church, and make preparations for any leadership roles we might have in worship or the congregation. However, the most important role we play each month is the role of intercessor on behalf of our congregation. Each month our deacons break up into small groups and pray for the families to which they have been assigned. Listening in on these small groups you might find prayers for healing and strength. Others might be praying for comfort for those who have lost loved ones. Still in other groups you might hear a prayer for a member who has lost a job or is in another transition. Down the hall there are those praying for adult children or a youth who has lost their way. Over in another room you will overhear prayers for a marriage that is struggling. Throughout the hallway of classes prayers are being offered on behalf of members of our congregation. When this prayer time comes to an end, our deacons again meet in a large room and join hands encircling the room. Another prayer is offered on behalf of the congregation and we join in singing "Blest Be the Tie." I am always moved as we sing. I look around our room and see male and female, black and white, younger and older deacons. All singing and knowing that they are a part of something bigger than themselves and they are called to an incredible role.

I think one of the most important roles our deacons play is that of intercessor. However, our deacons are not the only ones called to such a role. We are all called to intercede for one another in prayer. When we take the concerns of others or a concern for others to the Lord in prayer, we are exercising our important role as priests to one another in Christ. As Baptists we believe we are all priests. We call this doctrine the priesthood of the believer. As priests we do not need any intermediary between God and us. That means we are free to go directly to God in prayer. However, as priests, it means we also are called to intercede for one another in prayer. It is a holy and sacred role.

This Sunday we continue our series "Living on A Prayer" as we explore the important role of intercession. I am looking forward to this service as we will not only learn about this important role but also practice this role as part of worship. I will be looking for you as we consider the importance of prayer as intercession.

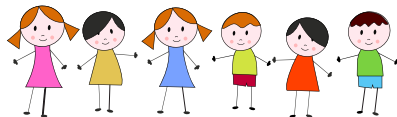
