This coming Sunday we will gather for worship and observe the Lord's Supper. This is always a special time in the life of our church. It is a time for us to remember the Lord's death and resurrection and it is a time for us to let the Holy Spirit examine our hearts. I pray you will prepare yourself for worship this week as we share this special time. As a part of this special service we will also remember those in our community in need. Each time we observe the Lord's Supper we also receive a benevolence offering at the end of the service for North Raleigh Ministries. In addition, we also have a canned food drive on this day to keep the shelves stocked at NRM.

For those who may be new to our church, North Raleigh Ministries began in 2004 as the result of a joint effort by the North Hills churches. Pastors from St. Mark's Methodist Church, Hudson Memorial Presbyterian Church, Grace Lutheran Church, St. Timothy's Episcopal Church and Trinity Baptist Church envisioned a "crisis center" in North Hills to aid local residents with food and other assistance. With visionary leadership from our congregations, North Hills Crisis Center was born. We located the new ministry in a house owned by Hudson Presbyterian Church and with a part-time coordinator and volunteers, we began to provide food and other assistance to those in our immediate zip codes. Over the years this ministry has grown and matured. Adding other congregations, moving to larger spaces, the addition of the thrift shop and a name change are just some of the ways this ministry has grown. However, the main objective has remained the same. The purpose of North Raleigh Ministries is to provide assistance of food, clothing, utilities and rent assistance to our neighbors.

Here is a sample of what North Raleigh Ministries did in 2017:

Throughout the 2017 fiscal year, 3,167 families, representing 6,171 individuals received essential resources in our Crisis Center. Additional support went directly to our community's children through Backpack Buddies by providing 5,379 weekend meal packs to children living in food-insecure homes.

In addition:

311,124 pounds of food were distributed,

\$27,000 was provided to cover utility and essential needs

\$72,000 was provided to prevent evictions

Trinity member and leader, the late Tom Dimmock, liked to say that North Raleigh Ministries is just Trinity on another campus. In other words, when it comes to North Raleigh Ministries, this is us! I hope that if you do not know about North Raleigh Ministries you will check our their website or drop by the thrift store. You can also find on the website a variety of ways to volunteer and make a difference.

This week you can make a difference in "our" helping ministry by bringing canned food and being prepared to give to our benevolence offering. Together we are making a difference in the name of Jesus at North Raleigh Ministries.


