A few years ago, while I was recovering from surgery, one of our church members brought me a book to read. It was a book that had inspired him and he had mentioned it to me many times. Now, with nothing to do but recover, I think he saw the opportunity for me to read this book. The title of the book was *Start with Why* by Simon Senek. *Start with Why* is not a devotional book or a "Christian" book but a business book. It was written to inspire leaders and others to discover why we do what we do and to make work full of meaning and purpose. Simon Senek writes:

Why do you do what you do?

It is one of life's greatest joys to wake up in the morning... every morning,
with a clear sense of why that day matters,
why every day matters.

This is what it means to find your WHY.

This is the start of an inspiring journey...
your inspiring journey.

Reading this book began my pondering on why we do what we do at Trinity. Why do we exist? What is the purpose of the church? Why is it important that we meet, worship and make disciples? As I have pondered these questions, I kept coming back to one of the most popular verses of scripture — John 3:16. In this passage Jesus says:

For God so loved the world that God gave his one and only Son that whoever would believe in him should not perish but have everlasting life.

I often call this the "gospel in a nutshell." In this one verse we are reminded of why we exist and what we are called to share as a church. That is why I am excited to explore this verse with you over the next several months in a series of sermons. We will be exploring this verse and what it says about God, Jesus, Salvation, Heaven, Hell and life in and with Jesus. I will be using this verse as a springboard for us to explore the great doctrines of our faith. I want to encourage you to be a part of this series. Plan to be present, bring your Bibles to worship, and engage mentally as we take this journey. **(Check out the sermon titles for the Fall online at tbcraleigh.com)**

FINAL MISSION TO SANTA ELENA, BELIZE!



So many TBC members have partnered with God and the congregation of Santa Elena Baptist Church to construct the Santa Elena Baptist Primary School. The school is wide-open with over 130 students and just had its first Graduation in June (13 students!). Pastor Manny has asked for assistance in building the walls of the two classrooms on the second floor of the preschool building. He already has funds for building materials. He needs willing hearts and hands. These two rooms will be tiled and air conditioned for use as school principal's office and computer lab.

It will take two weeks to accomplish this mission. Some will be able to stay for two weeks – others will choose only one. The dates are January 3-19. We will stay at the Aguada Hotel within walking distance of the school. We will have free days built in on Caye Caulker as usual.

Cost for one week (air fare, ground transportation, lodging, most meals, ice/water, water taxi, insurance and t-shirt) will be around \$1,475. Cost for two weeks will be around \$2,200 (yet to be calculated). Sign Up Sheets will be on the Sign-Up Board in the Narthex next Sunday. **SPACE IS LIMITED – so do not wait!!**

After this mission, our overseas emphasis will most likely turn to Disaster Relief in Puerto Rico.

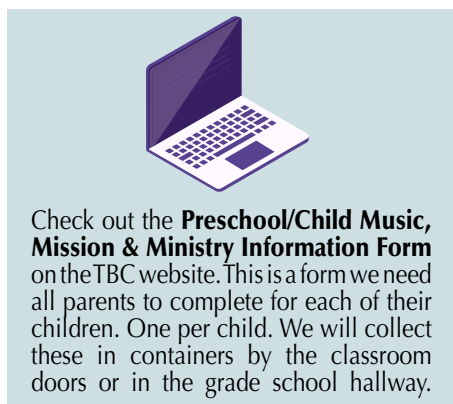
