Collected Sept. - Oct. **TBC Goal: \$25,000**

Mass Feeding is one of many Disaster Relief areas and is one of the first teams to go out. After a disaster, mobile kitchens are sent out as soon as a way is clear, to prepare meals for those who are without electricity or otherwise unable to prepare their own meals. The kitchen is usually set up at one of the larger churches in the town, because a big parking lot is needed for all the equipment and for the traffic coming in to get food and water. Where there is no electricity, our generators and propane make us operational. These kitchens are equipped to turn out thousands of meals a day, and the largest one can turn out tens of thousands of meals a day. Both men and women are needed to man these kitchens – and you don't need to know how to cook! Because of the quantities being made, it is a production line. The team leaders will know how to prepare the food and what other jobs need doing – what they need are the hands to do it. Each team also needs someone who can drive a forklift to continually get the pallets of cans and frozen goods out of the trailers full that have been brought. There are so many jobs to do and so many hands needed. A serving line is set up at the kitchen location for those who can get there to pick up their meals. Food and packs of bottled water are also sent out to neighboring areas by way of Emergency Response Vehicles ("ERV's") provided by the Red Cross. They set up at a central location such as a fire station or community center to feed people in the surrounding areas. These feeding missions are made possible by your donation to the NC Missions Offering.

FINAL MISSION TO SANTA ELENA, BELIZE!

So many TBC members have partnered with God and the congregation of Santa Elena Baptist Church to construct the Santa Elena Baptist Primary School. The school is wide-open with over 130 students and just had its first Graduation in June (13 students!). Pastor Manny has asked for assistance in building the walls of the two classrooms on the second floor of the preschool building. He already has funds for building materials. He needs willing hearts and hands. These two rooms will be tiled and air conditioned for use as school principal's office and computer lab.

It will take two weeks to accomplish this mission. Some will be able to stay for two weeks – others will choose only one. The dates are January 3-19. We will stay at the Aguada Hotel within walking distance of the school. We will have free days built in on Caye Caulker as usual.

Cost for one week (air fare, ground transportation, lodging, most meals, ice/water, water taxi, insurance and t-shirt) will be around \$1,475. Cost for two weeks will be around \$2,200 (yet to be calculated). Sign Up Sheets will be on the Sign-Up Board in the Narthex next Sunday. **SPACE IS LIMITED – so do not wait!!** After this mission, our overseas emphasis will most likely turn to Disaster Relief in Puerto Rico. MATERIALS

Photos of important family members AND PETS

PREPARATION

1. PRINT PHOTOS OF IMPORTANT FAMILY MEMBERS AND OTHER SIGNIFICANT PEOPLE IN THE FAMILY'S LIFE.

2. PLACE THE PHOTOS WHERE YOU DO PART OF YOUR BEDTIME ROUTINE.

FOR THE PRACTICE

1. After the child is dressed and ready for bed, sit with the photos and hold the child on your lap. Show the child each picture and say, "God Bless (name)" "God Bless Angie," "God Bless Papa," etc.)

2. As the child's age and speaking ability develops, have the child point to the photo, repeat the name, or say the blessing with you.

3. AFTER THE FINAL PICTURE SAY, "AMEN."

OTHER THOUGHTS

- This exercise is effective in its simplicity. Over time, even a very young child notices the routine of sitting down, looking at the photos, and saying the names. Resist the temptation to say more than the simple blessing
- KEEP THE EXERCISE SACRED BY LOOKING AT THIS PARTICULAR SET OF PHOTOS ONLY AT PRAYER TIME.
