I am so thankful for all who participated in our fill the truck effort last week. What a joy it was to see our congregation respond in such a generous way. I am also grateful for all of you who have already gone and participated in recovery and relief as a result of Hurricane Florence. On the bottom of this page you will find a link for you to follow as you continue to go and give.

This coming Sunday, we will gather at the Lord's Table together. I always treasure those moments in the life of our church. It is a special time to come and remember what our Lord Jesus has done for us. I would suggest to you that the Lord's Supper is a moment that captures the past, present and future. At the Lord's Table, we remember. We remember the words of Jesus and the acts of Jesus. We remember not only his sacrifice on the cross for our sins, but we recall his selfless attitude, his words of forgiveness of those who had persecuted him and his willingness to fulfill all God the Father had called him to do. At the Lord's Table, we remember Jesus' death, but also His life.

At the Lord's Table, we are called to the present. The Lord's Supper is just that...a supper. It is an invitation to come and join Jesus and his disciples. It is an invitation to all of us to come in the present moment and join Jesus in the Kingdom's purposes. We come to the table in the present moment as we are. We come to the table to be encouraged and sent into our world with the knowledge of the love of Christ. The Lord's Table is a moment that we are called to be "present" in the present.

The Lord's Table is a call to the future. At the Lord's Table we remember that Jesus died but we also remember that God raised Jesus from the dead. The resurrection of Jesus calls us into the future with the hope and the power of the resurrection. This means that we not only have the hope of heaven that strengthens us in all moments of fear

and uncertainty, but it also means we have the power of the resurrection in our daily living. We do not live like those who have no hope. We live knowing that the living Jesus is with us and the power of the Holy Spirit dwells within us. So, as individuals and as a church we do not fear the future, but we believe in the power of God that can transform any person, church, culture and future.

The invitation to the Lord's Table is an invitation to the past, present and the future. I am looking forward to joining you this Sunday as we say yes to the invitation to come to the Lord's Table.

FINAL MISSION TO SANTA ELENA, BELIZE!

So many TBC members have partnered with God and the congregation of Santa Elena Baptist Church to construct the Santa Elena Baptist Primary School. The school is wide-open with over 130 students and just had its first Graduation in June (13 students!). Pastor Manny has asked for assistance in building the walls of the two classrooms on the second floor of the preschool building. He already has funds for building materials. He needs willing hearts and hands. These two rooms will be tiled and air conditioned for use as school principal's office and computer lab.

It will take two weeks to accomplish this mission. Some will be able to stay for two weeks – others will choose only one. The dates are January 3-19. We will stay at the Aguada Hotel within walking distance of the school. We will have free days built in on Caye Caulker as usual.

Cost for one week (air fare, ground transportation, lodging, most meals, ice/water, water taxi, insurance and t-shirt) will be around \$1,475.
