Operation Christmas Child TBC SHOEBOX DRIVE

Trinity's OCC Kick-Off is Sunday, Oct. 28th during both services. Our goal is to collect 800 shoeboxes and fill the sanctuary steps! Shoeboxes can be found all over our campus beginning Oct. 28th.

The OCC Lead Team will be at the Fall Fest on Oct. 26th. We will have shoeboxes available for you that night. Brochures with instructions for packing will be inside. You choose the gender and age of the children for whom you will pack the boxes. Be a part of this local mission that becomes a global mission!

10/2/18 HURRICANE FLORENCE UPDATE

FEEDING: NC Baptists on Mission/NCBM and our friends from sister states have 7 large mobile kitchens that are serving more than 40,000 hot meals every day to people affected by Hurricane Florence. These 7 kitchens are serving in New Bern, Jacksonville, Wilmington, Lumberton, Hope Mills, Whiteville and Bolivia. 200 Red Cross Emergency Response Vehicles (and Salvation Army Canteens) are taking meals out from these 7 big mobile kitchens to areas all over the southeastern counties. Over 900,000 HOT meals have been prepared and served from these kitchens.

RECOVERY: All of these big kitchens have recovery operations working out of them. We are doing chainsaw, mud-outs, tear-outs, shockwave / sanitation and putting tarps on roofs. We have set up additional Recovery Sites in a number of areas. Our large Recovery Sites with Site Coordinators include: New Bern, Lumberton, Wilmington, Morehead City, Cape Carteret, Laurinburg, Warsaw, Scotts Hill, Pender County, Wallace, Shallotte, Bunn Level, Red Springs, Elizabethtown and others are being added soon. Over 800 recovery jobs have been completed. More than 2500 jobs are still open and we need lots of tear out volunteers/teams.

SUPPLIES: We are also distributing cleaning supplies, non-perishable items/canned food, diapers, baby formula, etc. to more than 20 different distribution sites from our warehouse in Red Springs.

LONG TERM RESPONSE: This disaster is so big that it will require a long term rebuild response to help get many people back in their homes. We plan on setting up three different rebuild centers where we can house and feed many volunteers to work on homes. We plan to manage the rebuilding of homes from these "rebuilding hubs". This will be a long term response that may take 2-3 years and require thousands of volunteers to help get many people back in their homes.
