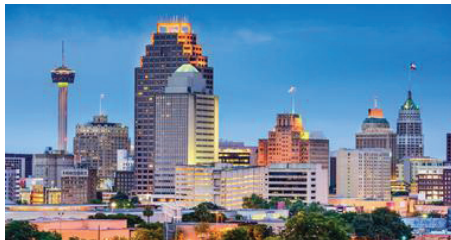

DEUTERONOMY 6 INSTRUCTS PARENTS TO TEACH OUR CHILDREN ABOUT GOD THROUGHOUT THE ROUTINES OF THE DAY. DO YOU PACK LUNCHES OR SNACKS FOR PRESCHOOL OR SCHOOL FOR YOUR KIDS? WHY NOT ADD SOMETHING TO HELP NURTURE THEIR SPIRITUAL LIVES AT SCHOOL, AS WELL?

HAVE YOU EVER CONSIDERED THAT YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL LUNCHBOX COULD BE USED AS A TOOL TO TEACH THEM ABOUT GOD? HERE ARE SOME IDEAS ON HOW TO MAKE LUNCH TIME A TIME FOR DISCIPLESHIP.

NOTE, SINCE OUR CHILDREN OUR YOUNGER, THEY COULD DO SOME OF THESE IN PICTURES. OR GIVE YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER A HEADS UP AND ASK THEM TO READ IT TO YOUR CHILD.

GENTLE THOUGHTS THAT FOCUS ON THE MIGHT AND LOVE OF GOD WILL HELP YOUR CHILD GROW IN THEIR FAITH AS THEY BECOME DISCIPLES OF CHRIST. ADDING THESE SIMPLE NOTES CAN HELP YOUR CHILD RECEIVE BOTH SPIRITUAL AND PHYSICAL NOURISHMENT EACH DAY.
