One of my earliest memories is sitting in a dimly lit farmhouse in Tennessee, with my grandparents. The day had come and gone and the night had brought quiet to the house. In this small house, at any given time, there were several generations of family catching up on life and encouraging each other. Grandkids played in one room. A game of serious Scrabble was happening in the kitchen and in the middle room (you really can describe it as a family room since every room had a bed) sat my grandfather in his vinyl easy chair. He would lean back and play his favorite album on an old stereo. It would not be long until you could hear the music throughout the house. The song that is seared in my memory was by "The Chuck Wagon Gang." A high singing tenor would cry out:

Jesus is coming soon, morning or night or noon, many will meet their doom, trumpets will sound. All of the dead shall rise, righteous meet in the sky, going where no one dies, heaven we're bound.

Have you ever considered how many hymns we sing about heaven? In fact, many of our favorite hymns are about life everlasting. We love to sing rousing hymns like "When We All Get to Heaven," "When the Roll Is Called Up Yonder," "Sweet By and By," and "I Am Bound for the Promised Land." Even some of the most popular contemporary worship songs have a longing for heaven. We are moved by lyrics to the song "I Can Only Imagine" or the words of "The Untitled Hymn." Gospel music has always had the theme of heaven as a central theme.

These songs move us because, as Ecclesiastes 3:11 reminds us, "God has made everything beautiful in its time and put eternity in the human heart." As finite human beings we long for that which is eternal. We want to know answers to our questions about death, heaven, hell and eternity.

This coming Sunday I will be concluding our series "Starting With Why." We will explore those final words of Jesus in John 3:16, "shall not perish but have everlasting life." The promise of Jesus is for this life and for the life to come. It is truly good news. I am looking forward to sharing this message of hope with you.


