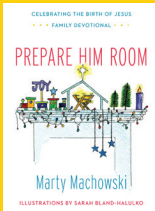
A Coloring Nativity will be available as well.

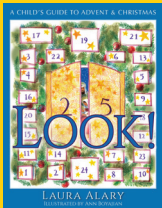

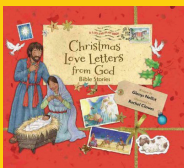
