

This past Sunday we began our sermon series on "Distinctly Christian." During the winter months we will be exploring the teaching of Jesus that we find in the Sermon on the Mount. I shared this past Sunday that there are five principles for us to consider as we begin this study. They are:



- The beatitudes are for every follower of Jesus.
- Every beatitude is for each follower of Jesus.
- The character of the beatitudes is not our natural tendency.
- The beatitudes are distinguishing qualities of those who follow Jesus and those who do not.
- The follower of Jesus lives in a different realm. The follower of Jesus is a part of the Kingdom of God.

Music Ministry


