Stewardship

This past Sunday evening in our January Church Conference, our treasurer, David Snyder, shared our annual budget report. This report is a reflection on our church's continued faithfulness in regard to tithing and giving. In 2018, our tithes and offerings were up 5% over 2017. This is a tremendous accomplishment. I am so thankful for each person in our church that gives out of love for Christ and in devotion to what God is doing through us and with us at Trinity Baptist Church. This year was a challenging year. The move back into the Sanctuary and into the new construction created extra expenditures. Just like when you move to a new residence, there are costs that you did not expect. In the same way we had some expenditures related to our transition to the new building. In addition, this year we had nearly \$900,000 in capital expenditures not associated with our new facility. These expenditures were covered by our giving over the past several years and through our Building Reserve Fund. Our church's faithfulness in giving year to year enabled us to not only complete our new facility but also have funds to address some large capital needs this year. I am so grateful to our Finance Committee, Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer, Trustees and most important our church for helping us complete 2018 in a sound financial state. Below you will find a portion of the report given to our Church Conference. Thank you, church, for being faithful.

TREASURER'S REPORT JANUARY CHURCH CONFERENCE

The total receipts for the year were less than the budget as follows:

The Revenues were less than the Expenses as follows:

During 2018, our church has experienced an unusual amount of large capital expenditures in addition to the completion of our new \$10,000,000 building. The expenses exceeded the revenue by \$24,000 which does not include the one-time charges of replacing roofs, paving and sealing the parking lots, new gutters and soffits, replacing HVAC and repairs to chillers, repairing sidewalks and replacing steps by the office and the recent boiler replacement and repairs. All of these items were either paid in 2018 or we have allocated from the Building Reserve Fund going into 2019. These capital improvements including three insurance claims (\$5000 deductible per claim) total almost \$900,000. Thank you to all of the Church Members who helped us during 2018 to navigate these financial issues.

I congratulate the members of Trinity Baptist Church for your continued support in your gifts to the church and also in controlling the expenses. We need your continuing support of Trinity's ministries and programs in 2019 not only financially, but also in your time, talents and prayers for the coming year.

It is with great joy that we expand our partnership with CBF Field Personnel, Marc and Kim Wyatt, and their ministry with refugee and international families here in the Triangle. As their Encourager Church, we covenant to pray for them and their ministry, to provide a helping hand in service, and to help support the ministry's program needs.

Currently, WHCN is planning to have a "class" for the 1-3 year olds that meets while their parents are in ESL class at the Smithdale apartment community.

One of the necessary requirements to begin this class is to have 2 teachers per class session focused on the 1-3 year olds. Presently we have between 1-4 children that come to class with their parents/grandparents.

As soon as we have 2 volunteers per Tuesday and Thursday from 1-3p.m., the class will begin. The same teachers are not needed for each class, but a rotation of teachers and a "typical" plan for the class is the goal.

BELIZE MISSION TEAM Wraps up work on Santa Elena Baptist Primary School



Thanks to all who lifted this final Belize Mission in prayer, and to all who participated in the Belize partnership. God blessed us in so many ways.

We completed construction of the exterior and interior walls of the second floor of the Preschool building – including forming and pouring 10 columns that will eventually support the roof. Pastor Manny Cowo and the congregation at Santa Elena Baptist Church were thrilled with the results. So were the teachers and students (160) at the school who watched the walls go up. This was a two week mission, and the second week we were joined by 6 members of Crossroads Community Church from Yorktown, VA. who will hopefully return to complete the project.

The school was a vision given to Pastor Manny by God many years ago. In 2011, as we finished work on Sunday School space at Lagoon Road Baptist Church in St. Margaret's Village, our team was shown the beginnings of a school

Santa Elena Baptist Church had prayed for 5 years for God to lead a partner to assist

them in finishing the school. Trinity, along with several other CBFNC churches heard God's call and accepted the tremendous challenge. It took 10 TBC Mission Teams to finish the main classroom 2 story building, build the first floor of the preschool building, construct an open air pavilion large enough for the whole school to meet in, and put up the walls for the principal's office and the



library/computer lab on the second floor of the preschool building.

To God Be the Glory as children for generations will attend Santa Elena BAPTIST Primary School and not only receive a quality education, but also hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ and be taught the Bible as part of the curriculum. May this change their lives, Santa Elena and the country of Belize.
