

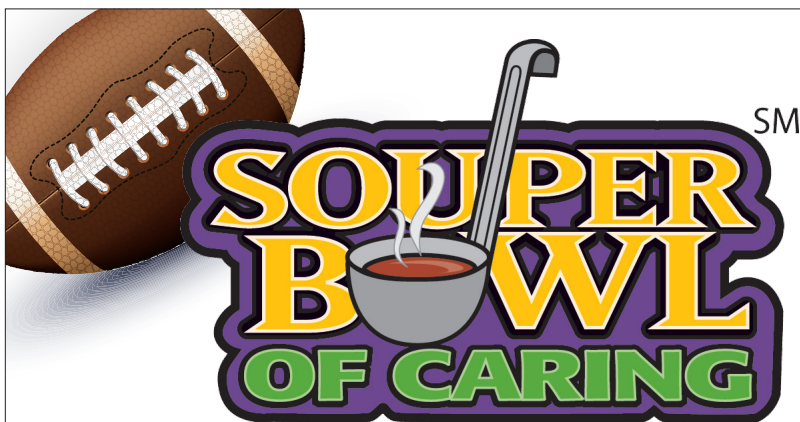

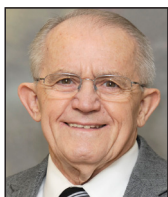

WELCOME HOUSE COMMUNITY NETWORK

It is with great joy that we expand our partnership with CBF Field Personnel, Marc and Kim Wyatt, and their ministry with refugee and international families here in the Triangle. As their Encourager Church, we covenant to pray for them and their ministry, to provide a helping hand in service, and to help support the ministry's program needs.

Currently, WHCN is planning to have a "class" for the 1-3 year olds that meets while their parents are in ESL class at the Smithdale apartment community.

One of the necessary requirements to begin this class is to have 2 teachers per class session focused on the 1-3 year olds. Presently we have between 1-4 children that come to class with their parents/grandparents.

As soon as we have 2 volunteers per Tuesday and Thursday from 1-3p.m., the class will begin. The same teachers are not needed for each class, but a rotation of teachers and a "typical" plan for the class is the goal.

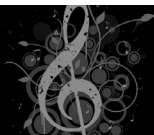

MUSICAL MYTH BUSTER #1:

"You don't need me up there with all those people in the choir!"



For the next several weeks, I'll be addressing some "myths to joining a choir" that I've been collecting over the years based on reasons some people will not come and get involved in choir ministry...

Actually, we do! Every choir could use more people to carry on the responsibilities of worship leadership. What if we had full choirs for services every week? What kind of impact would that make on our church and community?

A higher enrollment greatly helps when some families are away on business or vacation especially during the summer months when numbers generally decline. Sustaining what we have now comes to mind when we consider our future as a church and its music ministry; we need new and active members from all age groups to keep our choirs healthy and strong, vibrant,

and multi-generational. Our future is dependent on the willingness of volunteers accept the calling to use their gifts from God and to offer them in the act of worship. Worship leading takes courage, time, commitment, and teamwork to make our worship meaningful and to make His praise glorious.
