Life does not always go as we plan. In fact, what we discover as we experience life is that much of life is not as planned. All of us go through difficult times of struggle and loss. This coming Sunday night we begin a discipleship series that I believe has something to say to all of us. How to Get Through What You're Going Through is an 8-week study written by Pastor Rick Warren and his wife Kay, after the tragic loss of their son as the result of suicide, after a long struggle of mental illness. Their honest expression of questions and faith will be an encouragement to us all. The study is described in the following way:

Life often doesn't make sense, and dishes up a lot more questions than answers. We simply don't know why things happen the way they do. But we do know we can experience peace because God is with us and he loves us. Loss is inevitable. Bad things happen. When the unexpected comes your way, your world is instantly turned upside down. You long to understand why. Why did my husband walk out on me? Why did my wife die of cancer? Why did I lose my job? Why am I struggling with mental health issues? In this groundbreaking study, Pastor Rick and Kay Warren will help you understand the journey of grief and what to expect along the way. From the initial shock, to the unbearable sorrow, you struggle with reality and ultimately surrender on a pathway to peace and service. It's not a linear experience but with God's Word and his ways, he will carry you through it.

Grief is God's tool for you getting through the transitions of life.

You can have hope knowing God is in control, he will bring good out of bad, and he has a plan to use your pain for a purpose.

MUSICAL MYTH BUSTER #2:

"I can't read music, so I won't be of use."



For the next several weeks, I'll be addressing some "myths to joining a choir" that I've been collecting over the years based on reasons some people will not come and get involved in choir ministry...

Okay, so this has come up in almost every choir I've led in over 35 years of music ministry. Many people believe that being in a choir requires the ability to read music well. Actually, there is a mixture of musical giftedness in almost every choir at Trinity. I would speculate it is that way in most churches. It is helpful to read music because of the volume of work we do, but we have trained and non-trained singers throughout our choir ministry, and they all work beautifully together. We welcome people with willing, servant-hearts who desire to praise God through song. The ability to sing isn't always matched with a great ability to read music; many people rely on their ear and strong singers around

them and slowly build their experiences. Choir ministry is a process, not an end-result every week. We build on these skills and techniques to form basic musical concepts and interpretations from inspiring texts, and we move towards excellence in worship leadership. Our goal is to always be at least 4 weeks ahead on anthems and music for worship so that you have time to learn and build confidence. I think you will find that "no (wo)man is an island" in that we are all in this together and work toward making a diverse, musical family that God can use for His glory. Think about how you can step-out in faith and join a choir soon! There are so many possibilities at Trinity!





KENTUCKY MISSION UPDATE

January 2019

Trinity delivered nearly 2,200 bags than (more tons) of clothing to the Pine Knot Center (PKC) in 2018! Along with a few other deliveries from around the US, Hills and Hollers Ministries estimates that more than 52,000 individual items were received and processed by two to six volunteers. PKC is only open to give away items 10 hours per week! Please continue to pray for the ministry through PKC, and especially for Jim and Rita Cmolik, the ministry leaders.

During this month, a delivery including 425 bags of clothing, two toddler car seats, a crib mattress, three bicycles, several boxes of dishes, and a dozen boxes of food packets from Feed the Hunger were delivered to PKC. Deliveries are expected to continue during 2019.



The support of PKC is possible only due to the faithful team of TBC volunteers who pull items at North Raleigh Ministries each week. They collect and label about 50 bags per week. Each bag has sorted and folded items, ready to be processed at PKC!

Thank you to everyone who makes the deliveries possible (donating to NRM, pulling at NRM, moving bags to the PackMan Unit and loading the trailer/truck)!
