Words from our Pastor

In Philippians 1:3-11, Paul writes these pastoral words of thanksgiving and hope:

I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus. It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart and, whether I am in chains or defending and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me. God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus. And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.

As I complete my 19th year as your pastor, I could write similar words about my love for you and the joy of being your pastor. As we began our ministerial retreat last week, I asked our ministers the question, "Who gets to do this?" Who gets to spend time at work reflecting on God's activity in the world and in the lives of people? Who gets the opportunity to walk with others in the most important moments of life? Who gets the privilege of trust concerning others' most secret thoughts and struggles? Who gets the honor of joining God in God's reconciling work in the world?

Our calling as ministers is an incredible privilege of trust and responsibility. This is why I can say thank you for allowing me to live my calling with you. Paul's words remind me of several things concerning our life together.

Our life together is filled with joy. Yes, there are challenging times and yes, there are moments we might struggle together, but the joy is that we do it together. The blessing of our family of faith we call Trinity is a deep joy.

We are in this together. We are partners in the work of the gospel. We all share in God's grace.

God is at work. The same God that began the work of our congregation is still at work in our lives. We live our lives together with a confidence that what God starts, God completes.

We are still in the process of becoming more like Christ. Paul prays that the church might grow in love for each other, the knowledge of God, and the ability to discern what is best. My prayer is that we will never stop asking, "What is God calling us to do today?"

I want to thank you for allowing me to walk with you for these past 19 years, and I look forward to the years ahead as we anticipate with great joy what God is going to do. To God be the glory great things He has done!



MUSICAL MYTH BUSTER #3:

"I could never join the choir. I am too embarrassed to be in front of all those people.'



For the next several weeks, I'll be addressing some "myths to joining a choir" that I've been collecting over the years based on reasons some people will not come and get involved in choir ministry...

This is not one of the reasons I hear often, but one that is an obstacle to joining a choir. Many people have said that the pressure and performance factors of being in a choir are too much, given that family, travel, and outside obligations require a lot of time that may interfere with rehearing consistently. Consistent rehearsals lead to better comfortability in front of people; being a worship leader is a process for all of us, and we all are on different parts of development as a whole choir. At some point in time, musicians began a journey of choir participation to be in front of people, and "stage fright" is a very real phenomenon that strikes all of us. But the key to overcoming fear of being in front of people in a choir is consistency and knowing that you are not alone in doing so. God has called us to be in unity and spirit; therefore, we encourage one another and strengthen our bond by spending time together, learning the theological implications of "why" we do what we do, and rehearsing for worship leadership. Rehearsals aren't just times to hash-out notes and rhythms; they are designed to teach, disciple, and grow more comfortable within our calling as musicians for Christ. I encourage you to "step out of the boat" and grab an oar to paddle along with us...none of us do this alone. We are in this together! Come join a choir!

The Crisis Center is now a Crisis & Development Center. The goal in this evolution is to help clients get beyond the point of crisis and move them into a place of self-sufficiency.

PUERTO RICODisaster Relief Mission

Dates to be Announced

Hurricanes Irma and Maria struck the island of Puerto Rico in 2017 with a vengeance. NCBM has been coordinating disaster response volunteers in Puerto Rico since October 1, 2017 providing potable water, tree cutting service, temporary roof repair, laundry service, and cleanup of flooded homes.

The focus for 2019 is rebuilding roofing systems in the San Juan area. The hurricanes destroyed much of the roofing framework. Teams must be prepared to set rafters and install tin or similar roof covering. Baptists on Mission will provide most tools.

COST

\$600 includes round-trip airfare, insurance, in-country transportation, in-country logistical support, lodging, most meals, orientation materials, T-shirt and building materials. *In this era of unpredictable airline costs, we will make every effort to maintain this price throughout the year. Be aware that some teams may be required to pay a bit extra if ticket prices spike.

TEAMS

Groups are preferred over individual applicants. Participants must be at least 18 years old to participate (15 IF accompanied by a parent or guardian). Teams should be comprised of no more than 10 and no less than 6 members. A Spanish translator may be available most times but it would be helpful to have an interpreter on the team.

Sign Up List will be on the Narthex Registration Board soon. A \$300 Deposit will be required for sign up. Please begin prayerful consideration of participating on this first of many teams.
