

MUSICAL MYTH BUSTER #4:

"I don't bave time."



For the next several weeks, I'll be addressing some "myths to joining a choir" that I've been collecting over the years based on reasons some people will not come and get involved in choir ministry...

If we all stop and think about it, all of us say this very thing about a variety of stuff we are asked to do. However, the truth is that we always seem to find the time to do what we want to do. Each of us has a list a mile long of things to get done for ourselves, our jobs, our families, and in the community. Christian service, whether through music ministry or another vital ministry of the church, is something that takes much time and energy to schedule in our personal schedules. In order to continue ministries at our church (and any other church), we need people who value ministry, discipleship, and worship ministries in the process of building unity, fellowship, and a future for the church. Imagine our church in five, ten, and fifteen years from now. Who will accept the call to lead music ministries? Who will be serving in choirs? Will the same people be doing everything? How do we plan for a church of the future if today's servants step aside and there aren't leaders and musicians to take their places? The answer to those questions is when God's people discover with passion the ways He can use them musically. It requires time and effort. Becoming purposely engaged as a disciple of Christ challenges us to yield our time and talents to God and to be used in fellowship with one another. Considering what He has done for us through Christ, it demands our lives and our all. Continuing to tell the story through worship music requires people to give up some time and reserve it for His glory. It's not easy. There is always something begging of our time and attention. However, I challenge us as believers, disciples, and musicians to consider giving some time to worship ministry this year and begin a journey of service that will shape generations to come. The future of the church depends on us, and we have a story to tell to the nations!

PUERTO RICODisaster Relief Mission

Dates to be Announced

Hurricanes Irma and Maria struck the island of Puerto Rico in 2017 with a vengeance. NCBM has been coordinating disaster response volunteers in Puerto Rico since October 1, 2017 providing potable water, tree cutting service, temporary roof repair, laundry service, and cleanup of flooded homes.

The focus for 2019 is rebuilding roofing systems in the San Juan area. The hurricanes destroyed much of the roofing framework. Teams must be prepared to set rafters and install tin or similar roof covering. Baptists on Mission will provide most tools.

COST

\$600 includes round-trip airfare, insurance, in-country transportation, in-country logistical support, lodging, most meals, orientation materials, T-shirt and building materials. *In this era of unpredictable airline costs, we will make every effort to maintain this price throughout the year. Be aware that some teams may be required to pay a bit extra if ticket prices spike.

TEAMS

Groups are preferred over individual applicants. Participants must be at least 18 years old to participate (15 IF accompanied by a parent or guardian). Teams should be comprised of no more than 10 and no less than 6 members. A Spanish translator may be available most times but it would be helpful to have an interpreter on the team.

Sign Up List will be on the Narthex Registration Board soon. A \$300 Deposit will be required for sign up. Please begin prayerful consideration of participating on this first of many teams.




