The journey of a disciple of Christ was never promised to be an easy one. Jesus, in fact, said that if anyone wants to follow him, then we must deny ourselves, take up our crosses, and follow him. Matthew 16:25 says, "For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."

It is the practice of laying bare our hearts before God in prayer - offering up our desires, our sins, our will - in order that our hearts may be healed and restored to mint condition - the way God intended them to be. And, while we may feel the pain of parting with our will, being united with Jesus is our salve, our medicine, and our reward. Go now, and offer it up to Jesus.




