The book, *Hidden in Christ*, by James Bryan Smith is a journey through Colossians 3. This chapter begins with the Apostle Paul's proclamation, "Since you have been raised with Christ." In the first chapter Smith makes this claim, "Every single issue in life, every problem we face, every hope we have-absolutely everything hinges on the resurrection of Jesus." That is a very bold statement but Smith goes on to assert, "Life's fundamental questions – such as, Who am I? What happens when I die? What is the reason for our hope - all find their answer in the resurrection."

This coming Easter Sunday we will meet for worship as we do each Sunday. Sunday is the day Christians have traditionally met to worship because every Sunday is resurrection day. Easter is not just a once-a-year occurrence for those who follow Jesus. Easter is instead an everyday reality. We meet to worship on Sunday because we need our lives ordered by the Easter news. We need every week and every day, for that matter, to be transformed by the words, "He is Alive!"

The old saying is true, "If Jesus was not raised from the grave, then it really does not matter, but if Jesus has been raised, then it is the only thing that really matters." This coming Sunday we will gather to celebrate the resurrection. We will again be reminded that Jesus lives. We will be challenged to not only sing of Christ's resurrection but to become aware that the living Jesus is with us everyday of our lives.

Yes, Easter is a special day. It is a day for us to focus on the resurrection and affirm again that we believe that Jesus has been raised from the dead, and because of his resurrection, there is victory over sin, death and the grave. Jesus' resurrection is the answer to our living and our dying. Jesus' resurrection is the meaning and purpose for living, for those who would follow him.

I am looking forward to being with you on my 20th Easter as your Pastor. There is nowhere I would rather be than with my church family praising our living Lord. I hope to see you as we celebrate the resurrection of lesus.


Boyd Dimmock has been a member since 1974. She is a native of New Bern, NC. She has two daughters and six grandchildren. She retired from IBM as a Distinguished
