F.A.Q. ABOUT ONLINE GIVING

HOW CAN I GIVE ONLINE?

Go to tbcraleigh.com and on the home page in the right corner you will find "GIVE." Just click on this tab and follow the link. You can also access this link by texting **tbcgift** to **73256**.

WHAT OPTIONS ARE AVAILABLE ONLINE?

You can currently give to the general fund and indicate your missions giving plan of A, B, or C.

DO I HAVE TO USE A CREDIT CARD?

No, you have the option to use a credit card or make a bank transfer.

CAN I SET UP A RECURRING GIFT?

Yes, you have the option to give once or set up a recurring gift.

HOW IS MY INFORMATION

SECURED? The information you share on this link is not stored on the Trinity server, but it is serviced and stored at

VANCO, which has the highest security rating for such church services.

DOES MY ONLINE GIFT COST THE CHURCH IN FEES?

Yes, if you use Give Online there is a processing fee. You will be given the option to cover the processing fee for the church before you make your gift online.

HOW WILL MY GIFT BE RECORDED?

Our Financial Administrator will receive a report of your gift to ensure that your gift is recorded on your financial giving report. You will also receive an email receipt.

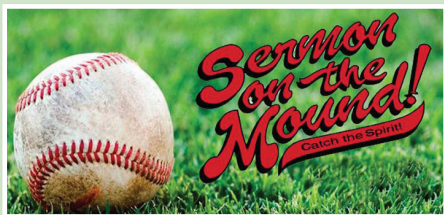

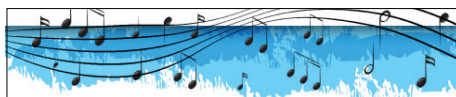

NC Baptists are sending teams of 8 to work on the roof of one home for a week. Hopefully we’ll be able to have these families back in their homes soon.

Trinity’s first of many missions to help rebuild homes in Puerto Rico is scheduled for June 9-16 this summer. Team Leader will be Chris Herrmann. Currently we have 4 persons signed up to go. **We need 4 more**, and surely in a church our size we can fill the team!
