Words from our Pastor

In recent weeks, horrific stories of attacks occurring in houses of worship have again caused shock and grief. What occurred on Easter Sunday morning in Sri Lanka to our brothers and sisters in Christ is beyond our comprehension. The thought of such a horrible act against people who were merely worshipping is more than we can fathom. In addition, another synagogue shooting, in the United States, has reminded us that the hate that our brave men and women of the greatest generation died and bled to defeat continues to raise its ugly head. All of this can create fear and anxiety. It is natural for us to have questions regarding our own church and its security when such events occur.

As your Pastor and the Under Shepherd of the church, I have the responsibility to give guidance spiritually to the church, encourage, and enable the ministry of all and the protection for our "flock." I have always said, "One job of the Shepherd is to protect those who would destroy the sheep." I used to mean this figuratively, but now, sadly, I also mean it literally. At Trinity, we take this responsibility seriously from the safeguards we have in place for our children and youth to the steps we take each week concerning security and safety.

I want to share with you that our Security Committee is faithful to their task here at Trinity. At present, we take many steps each week to ensure the safety of those who come to worship at Trinity. This includes security team members who walk our halls as well as our Raleigh police officer who is on site throughout the morning. In addition, we take other measures during our times of worship, which I cannot share in a public manner. We are also in continuous conversation with our Security Committee, Staff, and others who assist us in taking as many precautions as we can, but at the same time we remain a welcoming and loving place for all to come. I am so thankful for those who serve in this capacity at our church and give of their time and expertise.

I ask that you will pray that the day might come when all people everywhere can worship with freedom and safety. Pray for our brothers and sisters around the world who face severe persecution on a daily basis. Pray for those who are so misguided by hate that they would seek to harm others who are different than them. As our mission hymn reminds us, let us pray, "God's great kingdom will come on earth. The Kingdom of love and light."





CELEBRATING EASTER AS A SEASON, NOT JUST ONE DAY

Easter is not just one day, it is a season. Resurrection, in the Christian year is celebrated from Easter day all the way to the day of Pentecost. This year your family should have received a family resurrection calendar in the mail of ways we can continue celebrating the Resurrection for more then just a day. Another way to honor and celebrate that is with a Family Paschal Candle.

MATERIALS: Thick pillar candle, Glass jar or bowl, Symbols of resurrection: butterflies, flowers, or even a peacock (yes, peacock! Peacocks are ancient symbols of eternal life!)

HOW TO

- 1. Place the candle in a jar or bowl and explain to the family that the candle is a special Easter (or Paschal) candle and that it will represent Jesus' resurrection from Easter day all the way until Pentecost (the day that the Holy Spirit comes to us.)
- 2. Every night at dinner, place the Paschal candle in the center of the table and light it saying these words "We light the Easter candle today because we remember that Easter is not just a day, it's a whole season. Happy Easter!"
- 3. Continue the practice until the Day of Pentecost
- 4. Variations
 - Light the candle in the morning, at breakfast or at bedtime (any time that there is consistent connection with your family) Use a battery operated candle for toddler/baby house
 - Write your own words to say
