### *Words from our Pastor*

I want to thank everyone for their outpouring of appreciation toward Rev. Hal Melton this past Sunday. We are all so grateful for Hal and Roberta's ministry with us over these past 19 years. We continue to pray for them as they enter this new season of life. Hal's leadership has created a spirit of "being on mission" in our congregation and led to our congregation's reputation as a church that cares for our community and world. So many in our congregation have discovered a passion for sharing their time, energy, and resources with others because Hal modeled this for us. We will miss both Hal and Roberta's faithful servanthood.

Although Rev. Melton's retirement announcement was news to our congregation, it was not a surprise to me, our ministers, or our Personnel Committee. Because Hal loves our congregation, he has been transparent with me and our Personnel Committee over the past few years as he has indicated his plans for retirement. Although we did not know the exact date until the past few months, we have been aware of Hal's plans. This has allowed our Personnel Committee and Ministerial Staff to be proactive in making plans for this time of transition.

As we began 2019, we had several of our ministers make transitions of responsibilities. Rev. Eickhoff is now serving with our Education and Discipleship Ministry. Katie Medlin is serving as our Minister to Children and Preschoolers. Rebekah Gordon moved to full time and is working with our college students and young adults even as she continues to be involved with our student ministry working alongside our Minister to Students, Christian Davis.

As we have anticipated Hal's retirement, plans have been made for this time of transition. Over the past year Rev. Lydia Tatum has been shadowing Rev. Melton. Lydia has been attending our Missions Steering Committee and our Senior Adult Ministry Committee meetings. She has been working with our Homebound Committee and establishing relationships with those involved in these ministries. Rev. Tatum has been reaching out and establishing relationships with our mission partners and their leadership. It has been the intent of the Personnel Committee to make this time of transition as seamless as possible.

To be sure, any transition takes time; however, I am so encouraged by the work that has been done over the past year to prepare us for this moment. I am thankful for Hal and Lydia. They

both love our congregation and believe in what God is calling us to do. I am grateful to our Personnel Committee and their insightful and careful deliberation in these matters. Over the years, those who serve on this committee have enabled our ministers to grow and discover and use their giftedness while at the same time seeing the needs of our congregation as its primary responsibility.

Our Personnel Committee is still working with our Ministerial Staff as we consider other responsibilities which this transition creates. We continue to consider our ministers and all the gifts they bring to our congregation and how those gifts match the needs of our congregation. I am confident that this transition will, like others in our past, create opportunities for not only ministers to grow but more importantly, will allow our church members to discover new opportunities to grow and lead.

Thank you, Hal, for how you have modeled servant leadership over these past 19 years. Thank you, Lydia, for your willingness to say yes to new responsibilities and opportunities. Thank you, church, for being a congregation that is always moving forward in ministry and believing what lies behind us is the preparation for what God has for us in the future.

I count it a joy to be your Pastor.

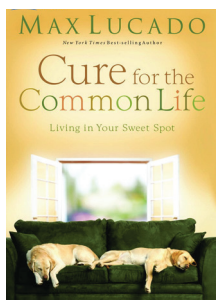

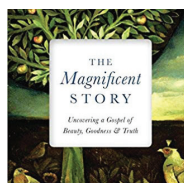

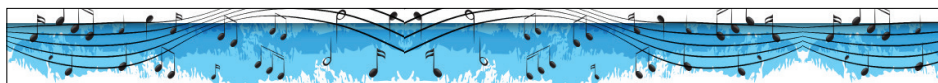
