Words from our Pastor

As we begin the summer there are a few things I want to share with you. First, it is my pleasure to announce the hiring of our new Weekday Preschool Director, Mrs. Bentley Williams. 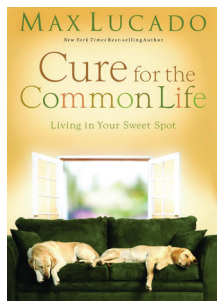

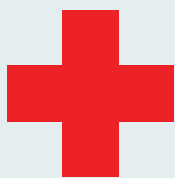
