UPDATE: WELCOME HOUSE

Thank you Trinity Family for the ways you love and support Welcome House Community Network - for welcoming children at VBS, welcoming teens at the Patriotic Cookout, teaching English as a Second Language, providing rest to our summer interns, donating furniture and household items, and making our Raleigh Welcome House Hospitality House a possibility through your hard work and kindness.

There are now 8 Welcome Houses in the Welcome House Community Network across North Carolina and Tennessee.

We opened a third Welcome House Community Apartment this month in south Raleigh in addition to our Smithdale (West Raleigh) and Larson (East Raleigh) locations. These apartments provide space for us to help refugee and immigrant families with ESL, Pre-school Readiness, After School Clubs and recreation.

REDIRECTION-NC

provides housing and support services to formerly justice involved women in North Carolina, facilitating a successful transition to community life. This program is grounded in the belief that with the proper assistance, those returning to the community can overcome the many barriers to successful living that incarceration experience can create. The residents remain in the program from 6 - 18 months. We help our residents obtain NC ID, apply for public assistance where appropriate and deal with debt. such as child support, they may have incurred while in prison. We support them in court appearances, reporting to probation/parole officers and meeting the conditions of their parole or probation. For those in recovery, we embrace them in developing a plan for their recovery, helping them find support meetings in the community, in addition to our weekly in-house meetings and Bible studies.

At this time we have three houses in Raleigh - one downtown, one off of Western Blvd and one across the street from



Trinity. We are so grateful for the support that the folks at Trinity have given our homes and our ladies. We have a group of ladies that play games at each of the houses once a month with a prayer time. We have a class that gives Welcome bags full of personal items. We have received Christmas trees at Christmas and furniture donated to make these houses look like a home. We have also received generous donations



from the church and individuals helping us to keep the houses running.
