

NEW SECURITY SYSTEM

Starting Sunday, September 8

Starting Sep. 8, we will have a NEW security system in place on our preschool hall. This is part of the process to help keep our children and volunteers safe & secure. It is similar to the Wake County Schools doorbell systems. Each door that leads to the preschool hall now has a door bell and camera system.

The doors will lock Sunday mornings from 8:45 am - 9:30 am and from 11:15 am - 12:00 pm. During those times, you will need to ring the door bell to be let in.

We will evaluate also using this on Wednesday nights as well as other times in the future.

How it works

The bell rings a system on the preschool hall allowing the ETC hostess to see/talk with those wishing to enter. The hostess can then unlock the door.

How you can help us

Identifying yourself. The hostess may know you but we are asking that all people identify themselves and why they are needing to enter the preschool hall. (Example: Parent, Sunday school teacher, ETC worker, etc). If you are a parent, one way to help with this process is to have your security band with you and you can show that on the camera to help assist in that process.

We are grateful for this added security measure. Please be patient as we all adjust to this new system, Please contact me with any questions.
