This past year has brought several changes to our ministerial staff, in regards to responsibilities. Our Personnel Committee has worked hard to help us utilize the gifts of our staff and meet the needs of our congregation. As we began 2019, we made several transitions on our staff. Rev. Karen Eickhoff, after 25 years of working with our Children and Preschoolers, transitioned to leading our Education and Discipleship Ministry. Karen also is the supervisor of our Weekday Preschool Director and program.

Katie Medlin assumed responsibilities for our Children and Preschool Ministry in January and has done a tremendous job in this transition. Rebekah Gordon began her full time ministry with us and is leading our ministry to College and Young Adults. In addition, Rebekah has been charged in leading our various church wide events such as Fall Fest, Patriotic Cookout and Fall Kick Off. Finally, Rev. Lydia Tatum assumed the leadership of our Missions and Sr. Adult Ministry.

In our August Church Conference, our Personnel Committee shared with the church that beginning this fall we will be making another staff transition. Rev. Spencer Good, after spending the last five years working with both Recreation and Administration, will focus his work on the Administrative duties of the church and Christian Davis will be assuming responsibility for our Recreation Ministry along with our Student Ministry. This additional responsibility is something Christian asked to lead and has come after several meetings with our Personnel Committee. As with any transition, we will be monitoring workload and effectiveness. Our plan is for this transition to occur as we plan the North Hills 5 K and begin registration for Upward Basketball.

Spencer will continue to be responsible for the supervision of our office, maintenance and custodial staff. In addition, he will work closely with Building and Grounds, Security, Furnishings, Columbarium, Office Automation, our tellers, as well as other administrative tasks and committees as assigned. Spencer will be responsible for the opening and closing of church office and to grant a constant ministerial presence to the office. Christian will lead our Recreation Ministry with the inclusion of the daily use of the ROC.

I am personally excited about this transition. During my 20 years as your Pastor, we have always had administration as a "part" of someone's responsibilities. As our church and campus has grown it has become apparent to our Personnel Committee that this needed to be addressed. Rev. Good has given leadership to this area in our church before, during and after our construction and I believe will embrace this expanded role. I believe Christian Davis will bring new ideas and innovation to our Recreation Ministry which will enhance our outreach to our community and build fellowship in our congregation.

I personally believe we have the right number of staff members at this moment for our ministry. We are blessed with a talented group of ministers who love the local church and don't simply do their job, but are always finding ways to use their gifts to strengthen our church. I am excited about our staff and their new responsibilities and I hope you will pray for them and for our staff and church. Below you will see the committee assignments of each minister.

BAPTISTS ON MISSION Disaster Relief

NC Baptists On Mission Dorian Update:

Hurricane Dorian caused several tornadoes and a lot of damage to some parts of the Outer Banks. Continue to pray for people who were affected by Dorian and for our volunteers. Right now, we have set up and are doing recovery out of Atlantic, NC to serve Cedar Island, which had lots of flooding. We are working out of Atlantic Missionary Baptist Church. We also have a logistic, chaplain and admin team.

We have also set up a mass feeding and recovery site at Cape Hatteras (staying at Cape Hatteras Baptist Church) to serve Hatteras and Ocracoke areas. Kitchen 3 unit is cooking today on Hatteras (food is being taken by boat over to Ocracoke). Recovery is also there. We have logistic, chaplain and admin teams there.

We have 4 large shower units, laundry units (3 of them), generators and water takers units all serving on Ocracoke right now. We are working today to set up recovery operations on Ocracoke.

As you pray, pray for those who were affected by the storm. Pray for God's protection and comforting hand upon their lives. Pray for wisdom, strength and sensitivity on the part of those who are responding. Two volunteers from Trinity Baptist Church are currently working with feeding at Cape Hatteras.

Rebuild efforts from Hurricane Florence continue in New Bern and Lumberton. We have a rebuild team going to Lumberton, 9/18-21/2019. We have two more rebuild projects scheduled – October and November 2019.

You can serve in this effort through prayer, giving to the NC State Missions Offering and/or joining the rebuild projects in October or November.

NEW SECURITY SYSTEM

We have a NEW security system in place on our preschool hall. This is part of the process to help keep our children and volunteers safe & secure. It is similar to the Wake County Schools doorbell systems. Each door that leads to the preschool hall now has a door bell and camera system.

The doors will lock Sunday mornings from 8:45 am - 9:30 am and from 11:15 am - 12:00 pm. During those times, you will need to ring the door bell to be let in.

We will evaluate also using this on Wednesday nights as well as other times in the future.

How it works

The bell rings a system on the preschool hall allowing the ETC hostess to see/talk with those wishing to enter. The hostess can then unlock the door.

How you can help us

Identifying yourself. The hostess may know you but we are asking that all people identify themselves and why they are needing to enter the preschool hall. (Example: Parent, Sunday school teacher, ETC worker, etc). If you are a parent, one way to help with this process is to have your security band with you and you can show that on the camera to help assist in that process.

We are grateful for this added security measure. Please be patient as we all adjust to this new system, Please contact me with any questions.
