# FALL 2019 MISSION PROJECT

As we kick off the 2019-2020 Missions year, our youngest members of TBC will have an awesome opportunity to participate in a mission project to benefit children in Wake County.

Every day, one of the thousands of emergency workers in our area encounter children in difficult and scary emergency situations.
