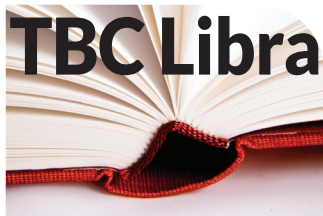

MISSIONS NIGHT WITH NORTH RALEIGH MINISTRIES

Wednesday, December 4 | 6:30 pm in the Fellowship Hall

Come for an inspiring night in discovering the many new ways we are able to make an impact in the physical and spiritual lives of our neighbors in need right here in Raleigh. We will hear from Executive Director, Donna Pygot; Director of Programs, Lesley Franciscy, LSCW; and Engagement and Communications Manager, Kara Gravinese.

Throughout the 2018 fiscal year, in partnership with our neighboring churches and individual supporters, we were able to provide:

- 318,487 pounds of nutritious food to the hungry
- \$121,245 to prevent eviction and disconnection of essential utilities
- 5,760 neighbors in crisis with much-needed services
- 150 students in need with 5,355 weekend meals through our Backpack Buddies program

From January to June, we have already been able to help 1,537 families (3,079 individuals) putting us on track to more than double our impact in this year alone. Our pantry's shelves are never growing stale, and we are sending food out as soon as it comes in to any who have need. Wake County children are receiving weekend meals through our Backpack Buddies program. And, with expanded Crisis Center hours, we are meeting the needs of more people than ever.

With two Licensed Clinical Social Workers on staff, we are able to get on the front edge of crisis situations by offering programs and groups designed to break cycles of financial crisis as well as meet the immediate needs of those entering our doors. Neighbors can enroll in Bible Study, Financial Peace University Classes, Healthy Cooking on a Budget Classes, and Parenting Classes. In our first FPU class, students formerly in crisis graduated debt free! A difference is being made, and you can help. Come meet some of the NRM staff and learn how you can support and get involved.

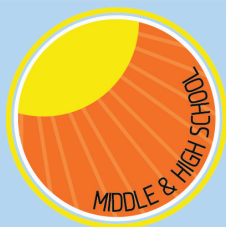

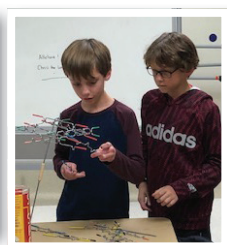
This is a special tree decorated with ornaments provided by you—the families of Trinity.

2. The Shepherd's Tree

As we approach the Advent Season we have many opportunities to "bring good tidings of great joy." One of our church's core values is to promote fellowship and care in our congregation. Over many years we have gathered on a Sunday afternoon in December and gone Christmas Caroling at the homes of our homebound members.
