

### HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

As partners through the Raleigh Baptist Association, we join together with Wake Missionary Baptist Association and Habitat for Humanity of Wake County again this year to make two new homes possible for neighbors in our community.



We kick off this year's Baptist Build on Sunday, January 19 with a joint worship service at 3:00p.m. hosted by Hayes Barton Baptist Church. We hope you will join us; and singers, we hope you will join the community choir by arriving at 2:00p.m. that Sunday for rehearsal and leading in the subsequent service.

All of the building fun begins at 8:15 am on Monday, January 20 in the Habitat warehouse on Westinghouse Blvd. as we build all of the walls for each house and raise them on the home sites at 3:00p.m.

We will need volunteers for our Trinity workdays, February 1 & 29 from 8:15 am to 3:00 pm.

As you begin your new year, we hope you will discover new ways to live out your faith and practice showing God's love to all people in real, tangible ways. Be looking for ways to get involved in missions this year!

### NORTH RALEIGH MINISTRIES

In 2019, a lot of transformation took place and I'd like to share a few highlights with you:

#### **NUTRITION & WELLNESS SERVICES**

NRM is now offering improved access to our food pantry. As a comparison, we provided food to 38 families in October 2018. During that same time in 2019, we provided 200 families with nutritious food. That's a 500% increase in the number of families we are helping to alleviate hunger! The provision of food is our gateway to introducing neighbors in need to our organization and the life-changing services that are available to them.

#### LIFE SKILLS CLASSES & GROUPS

We now also provide life skills classes and groups that have already seen some amazing results. 15 families on the verge of homelessness paid off thousands of dollars in debt and saved \$500 or more each in emergency funds. They accomplished all of this by learning how to live on a budget, save, and give back through NRM's 12-week Financial Peace University class. Another 12 families learned how to shop for and cook healthy meals on a budget through our 6-week Cooking Matters class. These families have been able to say goodbye to unhealthy processed foods, which helps to improve overall health outcomes.

#### **SUPPORTIVE & CLINICAL CASE MANAGEMENT**

In 2019, God blessed us with a Christian Social Worker who literally walks alongside families to help them set achievable goals and build resiliency - whether it's help with employment, landlord advocacy or transitioning in and out of homelessness. Our first case management client was so far in debt that her only option was to leave her apartment. We helped her and her child find short-term shelter, worked with her to save money and find an affordable home. Within a few short months, she was stable. At any given time, there are 12-22 families using this in-depth service.

#### FINANCIAL CRISIS ASSISTANCE

Among these transformations, NRM's commitment to supporting families and individuals with their urgent financial needs is unwavering, though the process has been streamlined. Qualifying families working hard to make ends meet but who have hit financial bumps in the road continue to receive the financial assistance for rent or utilities that NRM has always provided our neighbors.

Year to date, we have served over 2,000 families. Individuals and families who participate in our programs find they are better equipped to experience long-term stability. The need in our community is greater than you can imagine! If you are interested in helping to change lives, please visit our website to learn more.

What a year we've had! When I say we, I mean all of us, including our church partners, our donors, and our amazing volunteers in the Crisis & Development Center and the Thrift Shoppe. Thank you all so very much! We are looking forward to another great year of partnership with you!

# WHAT TO DO WITH YOUR CHRISTMAS CARDS!

As Christmas is over and the New Year is beginning, you may be taking down your Christmas decorations. Maybe, like me, you have beautiful Christmas cards sent to you from friends and family. What do you do with those cards? Here is an idea for you and your family that involves using those Christmas Cards to encourage your family to pray.

This year, take all of your Christmas cards and place them in a shoe box or basket. Call a family meeting and talk about the beautiful cards your family received this year. Explain that you are going to do something new this year with all of the pretty cards. They are now weekly prayer cards. Each night, gather together in someone's bedroom or over dinner and have one child pick



a Christmas card out of the prayer box or basket. Whoever sent you that card, becomes the prayer family of the week. Place that Christmas card somewhere in the house where everyone can be reminded to pray for that family. As you pray each night as a family, include that particular family in your prayers. The next week, pick a new card out of your shoe box and continue this process each week until all of the Christmas cards are gone. Let your kids decorate the prayer shoe box or write a letter to the family you are praying for. They can thank the family for the Christmas card and tell them they are praying for them this week.


