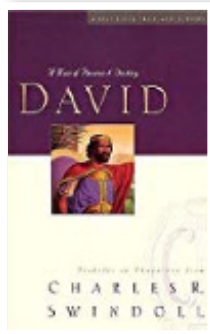

## 2019 Missions and Ministry Offerings

In 2019, over \$316,684 were given in missions. Our operating budget supported over \$84,088 worth of missions, \$42,700 of which went directly to local and national mission partners in continued support of ongoing missions and ministries. These partners are North Raleigh Ministries, Family Promise of Wake County, Jobs for Life, Redirection-NC, Habitat for Humanity of Wake County, Raleigh Rescue Mission, Welcome House Community Network, and Hills and Hollers Ministries. Additional operating funds support missions through the children's ministry, youth ministry, and senior adult ministry budgets.

In special offerings at Christmas, Easter, and in the month of September, Trinity gave over \$84,469 benefitting the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering (International Missions Board of the Southern Baptist Convention), the Offering for Global Missions (Cooperative Baptist Fellowship), the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering (North American Missions Board of the Southern Baptist Convention), the state missions of the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina, and the state missions of the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship of North Carolina.

In Shaw Missions Offerings through individual support and the support of the annual ROC'n Golf tournament, over \$120,313 were given.

And, in our Lord's Supper Benevolence offering benefitting North Raleigh Ministries, over \$27,812 were given.

This has been an incredible year of joining hands with God by joining in God's mission of love for the world. Thank you all for your generously missional hearts!
