In 2000, our congregation took a step of faith and called a 38 year old as their next pastor. I of course was delighted to have the opportunity to return to a congregation that had helped form my ministry a decade before. In the last 20 years, God has blessed us in so many ways. If we were to use the old metrics for measuring “success” in a church we would have to say we have had some success. In our 20 years together, our budget has nearly doubled. We have added over 1500 new members to our church’s membership role. Our attendance and participation has increased. We have added nearly 15 million dollars in capital improvements and are ahead of schedule of being debt free again. We have begun so many different ministries and have been on missions locally and around the world. All of these indicators are evidence of the health of our congregation. However, you and I know that the true measure of a congregation is relationships. So, when I think on these past 20 years I do not dwell so much on these measurements as I do on the relationships I have had the opportunity to build.

I think often of many of our charter members who have gone on to be with the Lord. I often think how much I wish some of our newer members could have known them and had fellowship with them. I know they would have enriched their lives as these charter members enriched my life. I feel gratitude that I was able to call so many of them friend and I also feel the weight of their legacy as your pastor.

I am blessed that here at Trinity I have been able to establish life long friends who have shared life with my family. You have shared in the birth of our children. You have walked with us in the deaths of our parents. You prayed for us in moments of crisis like Tyler’s accident. You supported us when I went through my cancer scare. You have celebrated marriage and a marriage to come with us. You have been with us as community every step of the way and I am forever grateful.

I am also grateful for new relationships. As new members join us, my life is enriched by learning about new people and forming new relationships. I also am grateful for our staff that has served with me for these 20 years. We are so blessed to have gifted people who love Trinity as part of our staff. They serve with devotion to God and to His church. What a blessing!

Most of all, as I complete my 20th year, I am thankful that there is still work to do. As I look upon our church and the changes occurring in our community, I am challenged that God has much in store for Trinity. As Trinity turns 64 and I celebrate being her pastor for nearly a third of her existence, I am excited to continue this journey with you.

Thank you for all you have provided for my family. Much of what we possess and what we have been blessed to experience is a result of your generosity. Thank you for your encouragement and for your daily prayers. I know that it has been your prayers that have given me strength these past 20 years.

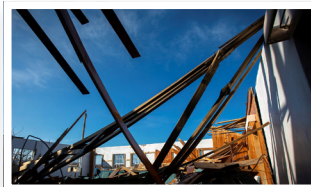
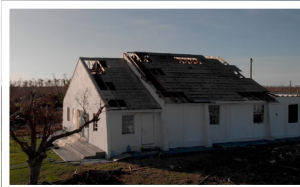

DISASTER RELIEF: It'll Bless You Beyond Measure

I asked Carrie Fisher, coordinator of the Baptists on Mission site in New Bern last year, why anyone should help fix houses that get flooded over and over. She said, Baptists on Mission is not rebuilding houses in New Bern that have been flooded over and over. "We live on the coast and there are hurricanes every year and 90 percent of the houses we have rehabilitated have never been flooded," she said. "Never. Florence was the hurricane that stalled over this area and it rained and it rained and it rained for about four days. Most hurricanes don't act that way. Dorian came through in September of '19 but there wasn't very much damage...more downed trees from the wind than anything, but even that was very minimal." Houses that Baptists are working on are not in the flood plain? "Not in my county," Fisher said.

Here's why she said you should join the Trinity Team and help repair houses flooded by Hurricane Florence:

"If you're a Christian you're called to serve, you're called to recognize need and respond," she said. "You have an opportunity to make an absolutely eternal difference in somebody's life. Every time they walk in their house, they'll understand that the love of Jesus was there to help them and lift them out of this pit of despair." In return, she said, you'll get an amazing amount of love, even from small things, like watching someone's reaction to a new exterior door that brings them tears of joy, because they can see part of their home being restored.

"It'll touch your heart like you've never experienced," Fisher said. "The harvest is so ripe here; people are looking for anything to hang on to. And to give a hug to somebody, to cry with somebody, to say a prayer with somebody...that's what we're called to do. Going to church is great, worshiping, singing in the choir is awesome. Doing this? It'll bless you beyond measure."

Oh, please, don't tell me. You don't know anything about reconstruction, right? Well, you can learn, can't you. Meantime, there is plenty of unskilled work to do.

HERE ARE SOME Q AND A'S THAT MIGHT HELP YOU BETTER UNDERSTAND THIS OPPORTUNITY.

Q. Hurricane Florence came ashore in September 2018 and there's still reconstruction work to be done?

A. Oh, yea. As of last month, about 1,200 houses are still in need of repair. Fisher estimates it will take several more years to fix everything.

Q. I thought the government, FEMA, fixed most of the damage?

A. You thought wrong. "They're here for a short time and then they're gone," Fisher said. "They do write checks, and most

of them are very inadequate. You have a home that's completely gutted...and they might get a \$3,000 or \$4,000 check from FEMA."

She said FEMA did buy RV's and give a lot of people a safe, sanitary place to live, got them out of shelters and out of cars parked at Walmart. Or gave them rental assistance.

Q. Is anyone else helping, besides Baptists on Mission?

A. Yes, numerous non-profits, including several other denominations, are doing their part, Fisher said – and they're all working together.

Q. How do Baptists on Mission decide who it's going to help first?

A. "That's the hardest part of my job," Fisher said. She said she gives priority to people who are disabled, veterans and people with children.

Q. How long is each mission?

A. The Trinity Team, six to eight people on average, leaves the church about 9 a.m. on Wednesday, and leaves the job site, headed home, at noon on Saturday. But you could come late. Or leave early. Or come late and leave early. People come for however long they can, two days, maybe. Or one day.

Q. How often does the Trinity Team go Down East?

A. The team made a total of 10 trips last year to New Bern, Lumberton, or Burgaw.

Q. Do you have to bring your own tools?

A. No. Some people have tools and bring them, but that's not necessary. Tools are provided.

Q. Where do you eat and sleep?

A. There is so much work to be done that Baptists on Mission has upfitted buildings that sleep 100 to 250 or so in New Bern, Lumberton and Rose Hill. At other locations you would sleep and eat at host churches. Each of our buildings has a kitchen, dining room, bunk rooms and showers, and storage areas for tools and construction materials.

Breakfast is served at 7 a.m., supper at 6:30 p.m. Both are excellent. At noon you eat a bag lunch that is, well, it's a bag lunch. If Mark Munday is there, and he usually is, he'll lead an expedition at least one evening to the nearest Dairy Queen.
