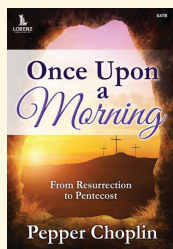
**2020 IS A GREAT TIME TO JOIN A CHOIR AT TRINITY!**

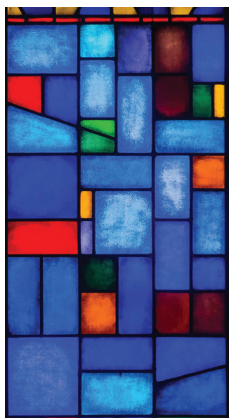

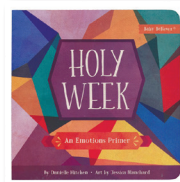
