TBC Library News

Prayer Jars



A prayer jar is a simple object that can serve as a daily reminder to pray. It can be filled with special prayer requests and can be used by an individual, or filled with an entire families' prayers. They are very useful in teaching children to pray and in creating a daily prayer time for families.

Wanda Brunstetter has written three books regarding prayer jars: <u>The Hope Jar</u>, <u>The Forgiving Jar</u>, and <u>The Healing Jar</u>. These three books are in the TBC library, but <u>The Forgiving Jar</u> and <u>The Healing Jar</u> are available **only** in the eBook format.

In order to have access to eBooks, you must have a TBC Library Card and be on the eBooks approved list. If you are not on the list, you will need to request eBook access.

If you need a TBC Library card or you need to be added to the eBooks approved list, you can apply online by visiting the TBC website at www.tbcraleigh.com and clicking on the TBC Library Online Catalog link or by going directly to tbcrnc.booksys.net/opac/tbcr/. Once on the TBC Library website, click on the Library Card Registration icon located in the bottom right corner. The link will go to a page where information is input for requesting a card. Even if you already have a card, you will need to fill out this form. The last item is important for requesting eBooks access. This item asks you to enter a 4 digit PIN to be used by you to access your account on the TBC Library website. If you are requesting eBooks permission, type --> ebooks and your PIN. If you already have a card, the system will not assign you another one, it will only give you eBooks and website account authorization. You may call Ron Brown at 919-782-3957 for assistance.

In order to use eBooks, you will have to add the Libby by OverDrive app to your smartphone, tablet, laptop, desktop, or Kindle.
