Dear Trinity Family,

I have shared with you in the past that the three characteristics, which are essential to our ministry together in this difficult time, are flexibility, creativity and faithfulness. I want to share with you some of the things that are happening in our congregation around those characteristics.

We are being flexible. As we are transitioning back to campus for worship we have had to learn flexibility. Whether we are worshipping online or in person, there are limitations. In our attempt to offer the best worship experience we can for the on campus worship and online worship, we are currently having an on campus worship service at 10:55 a.m. every Sunday. We are also offering an online worship experience at the same time. The online service is pre-produced for an online experience. These services are similar in sermon, scripture, prayers, and children's message and in most cases share the same music. We believe this is our best option at this time to offering our best in worship to God. I encourage you to join us either in person or online at 10:55 every Sunday.

We are being creative. I am so proud of our Sunday School Council and classes, Discipleship Team, and Ministry and Mission Committees. Our Sunday School Council is hard at work to create more opportunities for meeting in person on campus for the classes that are ready to make that transition. We currently have four rooms that have been designated for your use. We can accommodate groups of 25 meeting inside and 50 outside in the tents. If your class wants to use one of these spaces, please contact the church office. In addition, we will have a plan in place by October to move forward with Sunday morning opportunities for Sunday School and this includes families with children. We know that Sunday School is our next important transition.

In addition, our Student Ministry, Children's Ministry, Mission Committee and Music Ministry have been working together to design activities on Wednesday nights this fall. The schedule of these events can be found in the newsletter. I am so grateful to these ministries and the work of our Church Council to create these opportunities.

Our Adult Discipleship classes remain online at this point. I am so excited that over 160 people have pre-registered for our TNT study on Tuesday nights. If you want to be a part of TNT this fall please call the church office. We begin September 15. There are also offerings including Grief Share and our Wednesday morning Women's Bible Study. Other discipleship offerings will be available as we continue through the fall. Always check the newsletter and website for opportunities.

I am also excited that our Recreation Committee is making plans for opening of the ROC with certain limitations. Please be watching the website and newsletter for updates regarding use of the ROC.

We also are finishing week 1 of our Weekday Preschool Ministry being back on campus. We welcomed 135 children plus staff and teachers back to campus. Our Weekday Preschool Committee, Director and staff have done an incredible job in offering this ministry in a safe manner.

In addition to all of this, there are so many committees and ministries working behind the scenes to keep our congregation moving forward. Thank you to everyone who is being creative in ministry.

We must be faithful. All of the flexibility and creativity will be lost without our faithfulness to our congregation. We must be faithful in every way we can. If you have a responsibility of service, keep doing good. If you can attend in person or online, be present. In regards to our giving of our resources, let us be generous.

In the past few months we have discovered that God is at work and not deterred by a pandemic. God has been adding to our church. People are making professions of faith and also finding a church home. Others are reengaging in the community of the church. Some are joining us seeking to know more about Jesus. This is a great opportunity for the church to make a difference in so many lives. So let us remain flexible, creative and faithful.

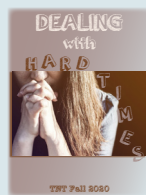
TNT - Tuesday Nights

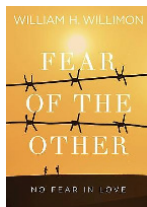

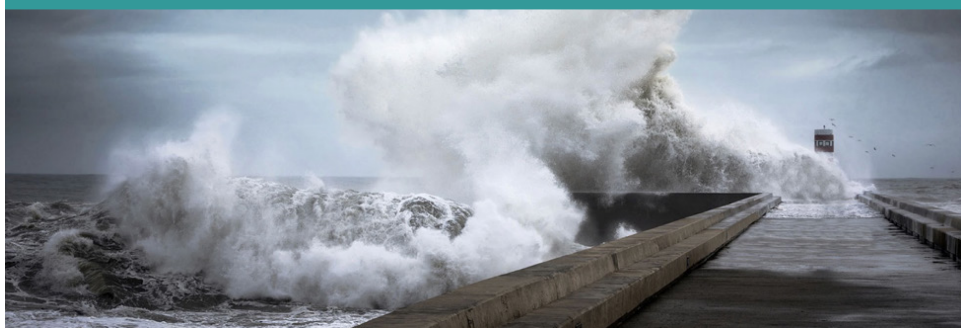

-CBFNC's Inaugural fundraiser for the Welcome House Community Network-

CBF of North Carolina announces "Welcome Ride 2020," on October 9-12 as the inaugural fundraiser to jumpstart the Welcome House Community Network (WHCN). Two weeks ago, CBFNC's Coordinating Council adopted the WHCN as a bold new missions program of CBFNC to extend Christian hospitality in the form of temporary housing and community outreach to vulnerable people in every NC city and town. Trinity has been an official Encourager Church in partnership with field personnel, Marc and Kim Wyatt, and their ministry to our international community, Welcome House Community Network, since 2018 and have supported their ministry through missions project partnership since 2017.

Welcome Ride is the first fundraiser to support the new WHCN and plans are to make it an annual event in the future. During the four-day period of October 9-12, CBFNC Executive Coordinator Larry Hovis and a small cycling team will ride over 200 miles from the beautiful Blue Ridge Parkway to the bustling state capital.

Because of health guidelines during the COVID-19 pandemic, this year's main ride will only feature Larry and his team. Every CBFNC congregation is invited to join the mission and the mandate of embracing vulnerable neighbors by giving generously to sponsor Larry's team. Proceeds raised will be used to provide seed grants to churches throughout the state to start new Welcome House ministries. The goal is to raise \$10,000 in order to support five new Welcome Houses in North Carolina. Fundraising will begin on September 15. Stay tuned for more details.

Churches and individuals are invited to follow Larry and his Welcome Ride team as they bike from the mountains to the capital on CBFNC's Facebook and Instagram pages. We will share daily "Where's Larry" videos and updates along the bike route.
