Dear Church Family,

I am so thankful for the ways that our congregation continues to be flexible, creative and faithful. Let me share some updates with you in regards to our ministry.

We continue to offer our online and in person worship service at 10:55 a.m. After much discussion, prayer and consideration, we have made an addition to our in person worship time. We will begin to have a limited amount of congregational singing as part of worship. We will do this behind our face coverings and it will be a small amount as we begin. We believe that this activity creates a minimal risk in our time of worship. As you know, we cannot eliminate all risk of the virus when we gather, but in all of our decisions we are weighing risk and ministry. We believe this is keeping with our goals and intentions. I know this might make some of you more hesitant in returning at this time and for others of you, I know this is welcomed news and actually might encourage you to return to worship. Continue to pray for our church, as we have to make hard decisions. In this time of response, nothing is simple, and everything has consequences and is complex.

We also are making available classrooms for Sunday School classes to use before worship. If your class is ready to return to campus or to have a virtual and in person hybrid experience, then please let us know. We have four rooms that are well equipped. We are increasing our Internet capacity throughout our campus to give us the proper tools for virtual experiences. We are happy to help you make a reservation for room use and also go over protocols for use. Call the church office or go online.

There are also other activities that we are beginning in October. Make sure you read your newsletter and weekly email announcements.

I want to let you know that in October you will be receiving two important mailings. The first will be the proposed budget for 2021. We will discuss this budget in Church Conference on October 18 and vote on the budget in person on October 25, according to our By-Laws. However, this year we are also providing a postcard ballot for your use. You can mail that ballot after October 18th or you can drop it by the office during office hours to register your vote if you are not able to attend.

In addition, at the end of October you will receive the ballots for Deacons, Trustees and Pastor Advisory Council. There will again be a postcard ballot for you to use if you cannot return your ballot to the church. All of the instructions will be in this mail out. Please be looking for these two opportunities to be a part of our church's decision making.

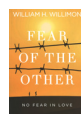

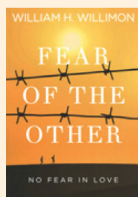

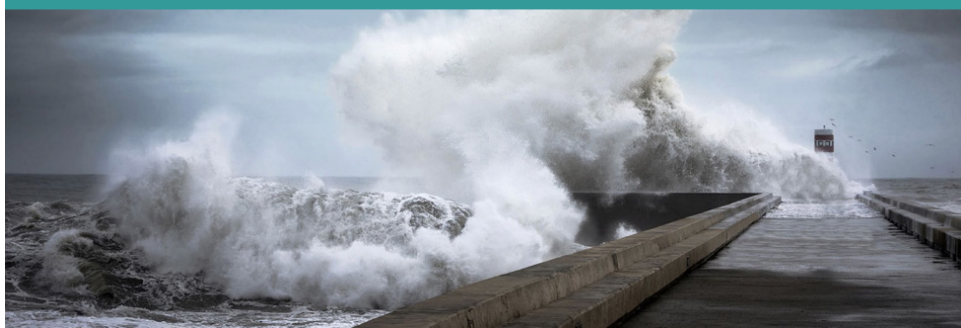

-CBFNC's Inaugural fundraiser for the Welcome House Community Network-

CBF of North Carolina announces "Welcome Ride 2020," on October 9-12 as the inaugural fundraiser to jumpstart the Welcome House Community Network (WHCN). Two weeks ago, CBFNC's Coordinating Council adopted the WHCN as a bold new missions program of CBFNC to extend Christian hospitality in the form of temporary housing and community outreach to vulnerable people in every NC city and town. Trinity has been an official Encourager Church in partnership with field personnel, Marc and Kim Wyatt, and their ministry to our international community, Welcome House Community Network, since 2018 and have supported their ministry through missions project partnership since 2017.

Welcome Ride is the first fundraiser to support the new WHCN and plans are to make it an annual event in the future. During the four-day period of October 9-12, CBFNC Executive Coordinator Larry Hovis and a small cycling team will ride over 200 miles from the beautiful Blue Ridge Parkway to the bustling state capital.

Because of health guidelines during the COVID-19 pandemic, this year's main ride will only feature Larry and his team. Every CBFNC congregation is invited to join the mission and the mandate of embracing vulnerable neighbors by giving generously to sponsor Larry's team. Proceeds raised will be used to provide seed grants to churches throughout the state to start new Welcome House ministries. The goal is to raise \$10,000 in order to support five new Welcome Houses in North Carolina. Fundraising will begin on September 15. Stay tuned for more details.

Churches and individuals are invited to follow Larry and his Welcome Ride team as they bike from the mountains to the capital on CBFNC's Facebook and Instagram pages. We will share daily "Where's Larry" videos and updates along the bike route.
