Dear Church Family,

I want to share with you several important matters and opportunities as we move through the month of October.

On Sunday, October the 18th, we will be changing our streaming provider. Our video team has been hard at work to upgrade our online presence and capabilities when it comes to worship. We will be changing over to Box Cast for our live streaming. Here is some important information for those worshipping online:

- **I.** If you watch through the website at tbcraleigh.com or Facebook, there is nothing for you to do but to continue to use those platforms.
- **2.** If you would like to use ROKU then you will need to download the Box Cast app on ROKU and then search and select the Trinity Baptist Church Raleigh channel. This is a one-time operation for users. Afterward, you will simply open the Box Cast app and select the Trinity Channel, which will be visible from your first login. These instructions can be found on the website tbcraleigh.com under "Watch via ROKU."
- **3.** Box Cast will also allow us to be viewed by using **Fire Stick, Apple TV and any Smart TV.** Just download the Box Cast app on your preferred device and search for Trinity Baptist Raleigh.
- **4.** In addition, the service will now be available on **YouTube and Vimeo**. You can find the worship service by searching "Trinity Baptist Church Raleigh."
- **5.** You can find all of these instructions and links to these options on the homepage under "Watch Worship" when you go to tbcraleigh.com.

We believe this, as well as other updates to equipment, will allow us to provide a more reliable and higher quality feed and production. I am so grateful for our wonderful volunteers who are working tirelessly on this. Providing this online presence is not only important in the short-term but for the long term as well.

On Sunday, October 25th, we will be observing the Lord's Supper as part of worship. We will provide disposable communion kits for our use. In addition, these communion kits will be available outside the office for pickup through the week of October 18 through 25 for those who are worshipping online. You can also use your own elements of bread and drink. We are looking forward to coming to the Lord's Table together.


