

#### The Incarnation: Discovering the Significance of Christmas



His parents called him Jesus. But the prophets, shepherds, wise men, and angels addressed him by other names---including Messiah, Savior, King, Emmanuel, Light of the World, Word of God, and Lord. Join Adam Hamilton as he explores the meaning behind these titles, what they tell us about the baby whose birth we celebrate at Christmas, and the significance of that Christ child for our lives today.

This book was the basis for the four-week online Tuesday Night Adult Discipleship study recently completed. And the book is the basis of Dr. Roberts' sermons during the 2020 Advent season.

No orchestra or bells playing and ringing in the Christmas season. It was for the best with the pandemic raging around us; the risk of singing and playing in close proximities was not safe.

Although the year has been quite empty musically, that didn't mean the music stopped. We have had soloists, duets, trios, quartets, and mixed groups continue to sing and play in worship. They have gone to extraordinary measures to stay safe and keep it safe in worship. I ask that you lift them up in your prayers and ask God to keep them healthy so that they continue to lead in worship, and I also ask that you remember all of our musicians in prayer. This season has been difficult. Choirs are like families, and we rehearse and fellowship close to one another throughout the year. Since March, we've disbanded until there is a safe time to rehearse once again, but many of our musicians have struggled with the disconnect. Music is our life. We give our music to the Lord and to His church with joy and gladness in our hearts! That is a huge missing piece this year for us all, especially those who are deeply entrenched in music ministry.

We will be back again! We have that hope in Jesus Christ, the one who is our hope! As we look forward to the new year of 2021, let's continue to pray for the total eradication of the virus, successful vaccination, and a renewed church that will one day praise God like never before! What a glorious day that will be!

In order to remain more socially distant we ask students to come during their classes specifies time frame.


