We are hopeful as more people get vaccinated and are able to meet in other small vaccinated groups, that your class may consider returning to campus. Check out these protocols below for making it happen safely and effectively. We are taking into account protection and love for all in attendance as we continue to fine tune our response. Our hope is to provide classroom media where we can utilize both in-person and online participation. Let us know if you need a TV or comparable device when requesting to return.

#### PROTOCOLS **BEFORE** ON CAMPUS GATHERING OF ADULT SS:

- Estimate the number of people attending and prepare the room appropriately by following the church
  protocols. You can obtain these from Reenie (rshore@tbcraleigh.com). Be especially careful to follow
  social distancing and masking.
- If you need to request a larger room based on the estimated attendees, then use the system currently
  in place with the approved large spaces. To do this, notify the church office and complete the
  appropriate forms.
- Note that the larger spaces are now available for multiple uses throughout the day, including Sundays.
   Your class might consider holding Sunday School at a time other than the Sunday School hours to help other classes that aren't as nimble as yours.
- Email Reenie, at least one week prior to meeting so the office knows which classes will be in which rooms and when they will be on campus.

#### PROTOCOLS **DURING** ON CAMPUS GATHERING OF ADULT SS:

- Evoke the rule of thumbs rule to properly social distance when in classroom. Each person/couple should be able to stand and hold their arms out in a circle without their thumbs touching anyone's thumbs.
- Always adhere to church protocols even inside your classroom. (masks, no food or drink, 6 ft social distancing in classrooms, elevators, and hallways, etc.)

#### PROTOCOLS **AFTER** ON CAMPUS GATHERING OF ADULT SS:

- Submit forms to Bonnie (bcole@tbcraleigh.com) of the office staff by Monday for record keeping:
  - A form or email to church office of who attended in person –list class, teacher, and classroom number.
  - A record of attendance of all participating for that week's class session (online or in-person) as normal




