Last year we declared that Jesus is alive even as we had to do it separated from one another. This year we will be able to gather and make the declaration that Jesus lives. It is a reminder that God is at work in our darkest of times. No matter what we pass through, the Easter declaration remains: "He is Risen! He Is Risen indeed." 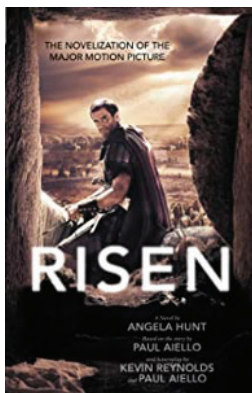
## NOMINATING COMMITTEE

But as the body still remains missing, Clavius commits to a quest for the truth--and answers that will not only shake his life but echo throughout all of history. ## PROTOCOLS BEFORE ON CAMPUS GATHERING OF ADULT SS:

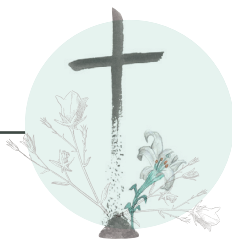
- Estimate the number of people attending and prepare the room appropriately by following the church protocols. You can obtain these from Reenie ([rshore@tbcrleigh.com](mailto:rshore@tbcrleigh.com)). Be especially careful to follow social distancing and masking.
- If you need to request a larger room based on the estimated attendees, then use the system currently in place with the approved large spaces. To do this, notify the church office and complete the appropriate forms.
- Note that the larger spaces are now available for multiple uses throughout the day, including Sundays. Your class might consider holding Sunday School at a time other than the Sunday School hours to help other classes that aren't as nimble as yours.
- Email Reenie, at least one week prior to meeting so the office knows which classes will be in which rooms and when they will be on campus.

## PROTOCOLS DURING ON CAMPUS GATHERING OF ADULT SS:

- Evoke the rule of thumbs rule to properly social distance when in classroom. Each person/couple should be able to stand and hold their arms out in a circle without their thumbs touching anyone's thumbs.
- Always adhere to church protocols even inside your classroom. (masks, no food or drink, 3 ft social distancing in classrooms, 2 unrelated people on elevators, and 6 ft in hallways, etc.)

  - A form or email to church office of who attended in person -list class, teacher, and classroom number.

## A NOTE FROM HILLS & HOLLERS MINISTRIES

Dear Church Family,

For many reasons, we needed to close our Community Closet location at the advent of COVID-19. The decision was not simply a precaution during the pandemic. The work to minister to 900 families through our center was overwhelming. As Rita and I have aged we've found ourselves unable to keep up with the many needs before us. At a time when most folks would have considered "retirement", we discerned a need to continue bringing moments of pastoral comfort to the people of McCreary County, but in a more intimate setting. The vision for our "New Life Center" began to materialize, affording us a unique opportunity to meet a very special group in our community. Through one-on-one meetings with caregivers of infant children, we can help bring them critical items of need for their babies; whether a young first-time Mom, Foster Parent, or veteran Grandparent.

Since launching this outreach, three weeks ago, I've had a number of people ask how they might contribute.
