I am excited to share with you about two recognitions from Baptist Women in Ministry of North Carolina. First, we are very proud that BWIMNC has recognized Rev. Karen Eickhoff as their 2021 The Anne Thomas Neil award recipient. This award is given to individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the cause of women in ministry. Karen has not only been a faithful minister at Trinity but also a contributor to the greater Baptist life. She has encouraged women and men to consider the importance of following God's call whether as a vocational minister or a layperson. We celebrate with Karen and this recognition.

In addition, Trinity Baptist Church has been recognized by BWIMNC as the recipient of their 2021 "Church Award." The Church Award is given to congregations who are exemplary in supporting and encouraging the cause of women in ministry. Executive Director Ka'thy Gore-Chappell informed me that this process is independent from the individual award process. 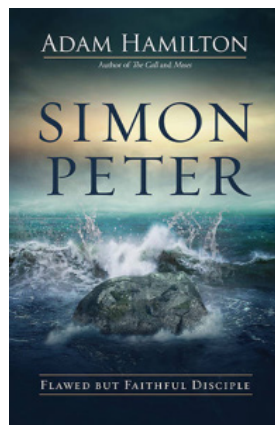

Worship Service

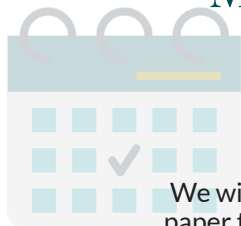
Sunday, May 30 at 10:55a.m.
