Sunday School Updates

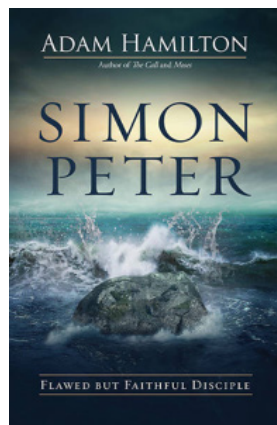

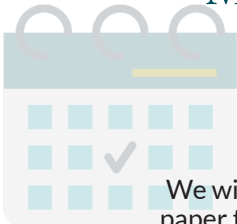
