What on Earth am I Here For? is the title of the new edition of Rick Warren's best-selling book The Purpose Driven Life. The book begins with this passage from Proverbs 11:28: "A life devoted to things is a dead life, a stump; a God shaped life is a flourishing tree." The events of the recent year have caused many of us to ask hard questions about life. We are asking questions about how we want to spend our time and we are resetting priorities. The work place is changing, family life has been altered and the church has to pivot into new ways of ministry. I have found that when life is changing rapidly I need to re-visit my core beliefs and purpose. Maybe you need to do the same. That is why I am excited for us to journey for 40 days together during October and November considering the question, "What am I here for?"

Our study will be offered in person on Wednesday nights and virtually through zoom. 
