Belong. Become. Be.

This summer we experienced a brief window of being able to return to worship, ministry and programs, as we had known prior to the pandemic. Those few Sundays were filled with singing, gathering and greeting without the protocols we had to practice in the days prior and now in the last few months. In the past two months we have had to return to some of our protocols and be more careful, especially in regard to our children and preschool ministries. Some of us have returned to our virtual offerings for worship and Bible study. I am so appreciative of all who have made our virtual offerings viable and meaningful.

As I reflect on what I have learned as your pastor over the past 18 months, I wanted to share a few words of encouragement with you.

First, I want to encourage you to show grace to one another. God has been teaching me that it is one thing to talk about grace and receive grace but it takes the work of the spirit in your life to offer grace to others. Our tendency is to judge others and to make assumptions about others who disagree with us or are choosing a different response to the pandemic in their daily routine. God has been showing me that I don't always know what is in the heart of another or the backstory of others who might be choosing a different response than me. God has been reminding me to show grace to others and hoping others will show me grace as well.

Second, I want to encourage you to be faithful. I have said to numerous people over these last few months that our church is strong and faithful. You have proven your faithfulness in so many ways. I shared with our deacons at the very beginning of the pandemic that what was going to be difficult. Sadly, this has proven to be true. I cannot fully express the sense of grief and disappointment I have experienced during this time. However, whenever I am at my lowest place, I remember the vast majority of you who remain faithful in all ways. Your faithfulness has encouraged me and I know it encourages others. Keep doing what you are doing. As we are encouraged by scripture "do not grow weary in doing good."

Finally, let me remind you to rejoice. I am reminded of two passages of scripture everyday. The first is the proclamation of Psalm 118:24, This is the day that the Lord has made. I will rejoice and be glad in it. The choice is mine each day to choose to receive this day as a gift from God. I can choose to rejoice in what God is doing everyday. The other passage comes from Jeremiah 29. Jeremiah is reminding those who are in exile in Babylon that they are going to have to learn how to make a life in a changed situation. They all wanted to go home to Jerusalem, but Jeremiah tells them that although one day some people will return many of them would live and die in Babylon.

So, Jeremiah writes, Build houses and live in them; plant gardens and eat what they produce. Take wives and have sons and daughters; take wives for your sons, and give your daughters in marriage, that they may bear sons and daughters; multiply there, and do not decrease. But seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord on its behalf, for in its welfare you will find your welfare. (Jeremiah 29:5-7) In other words, Jeremiah tells the people to stop waiting to live.

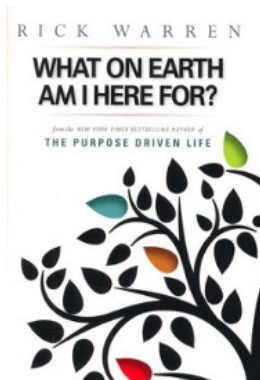

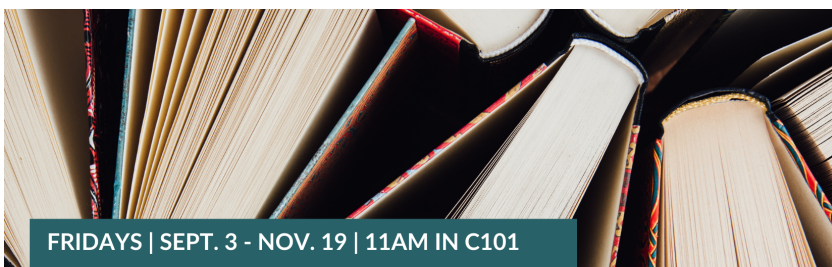
